Potential Insider Threat / Extremist in the United States Army

POSSIBLE IDENTIFICATION OF AN ACTIVE DUTY FIELD GRADE OFFICER ESPOUSING RADICAL VIEWS

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It is believed there is an individual espousing serious racial views – including white racial superiority, separatism, nationalism – as well as anti-government leanings that include the discussion of insurrection, violence towards superior Officers, and overthrow of the legitimate US government.

In addition to not being in keeping with standards of the United States Army, it is believed that some of his comments and viewpoints present a potential CI/Security concern.

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Additional Notes

• All screenshots and pictures provided are presented in an unaltered format. The only manipulation that has been performed is photo cropping for readability.

• The source for all information listed can be found in the 'notes section' below each slide in this power point presentation. It includes a hyperlink to the location of any information found on the internet. Clarifying statements or helpful resources have also been included.

• All following screenshots, comments, and links were current as of 21SEP2019, at 2130 EST.

Executive Summary

There is a user who was noticed on reddit.com/r/army, who goes by the online name of 'Nebor'. It was noted by several regular users that this individual, who self-identifies as an Active Duty (AGR) Infantry Officer in the United States Army, with the rank of Major, holds some extreme view-points, and routinely engages in racist rhetoric, and anti-government conversations. His comments have included hate speech usage towards multiple minority groups, holocaust denial, explaining how he would execute a US insurrection/insurgency campaign, and other extreme viewpoints that have led to concern that he may be a serious insider threat. In addition to being a potential violation of online conduct for the Army (ALARACT 061/2019 - PROFESSIONALIZATION OF ONLINE CONDUCT), the statements expressed, particularly violence towards superior Commissioned Officers, were found to be disturbing.

Through the utilization of open-source material, and PII gathered from his comments, an attempt was made to identify this individual. Several user profiles on different websites were discovered using the 'Nebor' username, that we believe link to the same person.

The following was discovered through open-source means and compiled to form a profile of the individual. It is believed that this individual has been identified as <u>MAJ William Jeffrey Poole, USA, IN</u>, currently stationed at FT Benning Georgia. The following slides will attempt to highlight the comments made that are believed to be dangerous and not in keeping with Army values, lay out the PII collected through these open source means, how they are interconnected, and how his identification was potentially made.

If you had combat loads of ammo and were moving before them you could deny them access to their own arms rooms. From there, depending on your location in the country, probably contact the national guard, as they'd be the largest command structures to reliably defect in the event of civil war.

He discusses 'rousing troops', as well as taking action in the face of a second civil war with secession goals. He believes things are 'heating up'. He also references the 'Turner Diaries', which depicts a violent revolution in the United States which leads to the overthrow of the <u>federal government</u>, <u>nuclear war</u>, and, ultimately, a race war leading to the systematic extermination of non-whites.

The Dean of Student affairs called me into a meeting with him and the UT police. Texas Penal Code is pretty clear that it can't be illegal to have a firearm in a place you live:

For purposes of this section, "premises" includes real property and a recreational vehicle that is being used as living quarters, regardless of whether that use is temporary or permanent.

I explained this to the police, and they agreed and left. The dean still said I had violated school policy, and that I would be subject to admonishment. I asked what that meant, and he said that was it, he had just verbally admonished me.

This was back before your concealed carry license allowed you to carry in university buildings in Texas (though you could still carry on the school grounds outside of buildings at the time.)

I guess I always assumed that any restrictions via a lease would be invalid per the Texas constitution, but I was dealing with a state entity, not a private private property owner.

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



The best way to find housing is mysteriously through ahrn.com. I'd never heard of it either, but trust me. I split a 3,500 square foot, 2 year old, beautiful house just out the North Fort Gate with a Major. Rent was \$1500 a month and he paid \$1000 of it to get the master suite.

My entire time (nearly 5 years) at Fort Polk I almost never had more than \$1000 a month in expenses. A little more than half that time was deployed. I left there with hundreds of thousands of dollars in liquid assets. I also saw guys try to buy their way out of the Fort Polk blues by spending thousands a month on new TVs, guns, trucks, etc.

I'm going to level with you: This isn't going to be a great time. But if you play your cards right, you'll never have to come back. Go to all the schools you can. Make it well known to your command that you want to deploy no matter what. Make sure your branch manager knows you want to deploy. You're kind of screwed since 3/10 is currently deployed (I sat next to their inbound BDE CDR a couple weeks ago at a conference at Fort Bragg.) Everyone will have a patch but you. But the installation gets WIAS taskers (requests for individuals to deploy) every week. Once you knock out your KD time in 3/10 (PL, XO) *don't dick around on staff.* Ask to go to Ops Group and be an OC/T. Yeah, it'll suck too, you'll spend a ton of time out in the box but it's a great OER and it might save you from an assignment at Fort Irwin, Fort Polk or Hohenfels down the road.

Socially... it's not gonna be good. The local girls are fat and dumb for the most part. We called them swamp donkeys. The general rule in Leesville is that if you see someone hot, that's because someone imported her from the outside world. There are no hot single girls in Leesville. The best bet for attractive single women are new female officers PCSing in (I bet I'll never say that again...) Get in good with the nurses at BJACH. Don't fuck all of them. You need one to be your wingwoman to introduce you to the other nurses and bring the gaggle of nurses to your parties. Avoid Paradise & Zydeco. They're full of drunk joes and you'll just wind up in trouble. Beware Joe-sephinas trying to bag a male officer, particularly on Tinder. Seriously. I saw multiple LTs go down for it while I was there. One LT was even sleeping with his soldiers wives. The isolation at Polk causes people to do desperate things, and as an officer you'll be more isolated than most. Tinder tips: Look for profiles with colleges listed, West Point being an obvious super-like, look for nursing schools, medical schools, law schools. That'll help steer you clear of female soldiers.

I had an extremely tight knit group of friends. I was fortunate enough to be in a BN where literally every single company grade officer was single, so we'd all hit the VFW together Friday night (the VFW is the nicest bar in town, and the apple pie moonshine is legit) and then bring it back to one of the bigger houses for a house party. Then we'd caravan to Alexandria on Saturdays to see a movie and eat at a decent restaurant (like Outback or Copeland's.)

I'm trying to think of what else I'm missing.... Get a dog. It'll keep you company. Also I dated two of the veterinarians assigned there because of said dog. Oh, and the chick at the front desk of the vet clinic might be dirty hot with her tats and flicking her tongue stud at you, but one of my joes caught something he couldn't get rid of from her.

There are hot college chicks in Lake Charles at McNeese University. If you play your cards right you can have a place to crash on the weekends and a way hotter girl than you'll find in Leesville just an hour and fifteen minutes away. Check out Luna Bar and Grill on Ryan St, I went out with a couple of the waitresses from there and they're usually all 8+.







There is a 'Nebor' account on bodybuilding.com that expresses similar extreme views on race, religion, and anti Semitism. This post is from 2016 and lists his location as Hawaii, and age as 34. The Location is manually entered, while the age is based on birthdate.

In a particularly notable exchange, when asked what his 'rank is', he responds;

"Durka durka durka jihad durka?

I'm a captain, about to be a major next year (this post was 2016). And I work for US Army Pacific Command."

These statements coincide with other identifying statements he has made on reddit.

The discrepancy is because google caches the twitter information from when it was created. So the original account name was 'Jeff Poole', and the description was 'Staff officer, news junkie, taco bell aficionado & runner. Honolulu, HI.'. At some point, he changed the username and profile description, and his name no longer appears anywhere on this twitter account. However, it is still cached through google, and still identifies him with this twitter account. Additionally, the pictures featured seem to match with the Facebook account found for Jeff Poole.

It was always kinda crazy to me that after The Battle of Shok Valley, $^{[1]} \oplus$ The Battle of Wanat $^{[2]} \oplus$, and The Battle of Kamdesh $^{[3]} \oplus$ that we were like, "you know what, fuck Nuristan," and left.

There hasn't been a permanent US presence in Nuristan since **2009**. We would get sporadic contact with the Afghan Security Forces up there when I was in Kunar, but they were on their own in Indian country. We wouldn't even send Apaches up there to help them for fear they'd be shot down with no means of rescue. In 2012 we flew in to the former Keating site with about 80 Americans from 4-4 IBCT and 40 ANA soldiers under cover of darkness as a "show of force." I flew up there in 2012 with 4/4. Approximately 40 of us stayed overnight as a 'show of force.' Keep in mind that the entire province of Nuristan had been wholly abandoned for years at that point. Even the coalition ANP/ANA advisers lived in Laghman. They'd get constant reports of ANSF getting wrecked by the Taliban, and requests for support, but we wouldn't even send aircraft up there to support them or medevac their wounded. We stayed the night, around 8 hours before we got pulled out due to intel that the locals were going to swarm us.

Also, I worked with a 1SG that was the platoon sergeant during the battle, 1SG Hill. He was awarded the silver star for his actions there.

I'm looking forward to these films.

I was there (I'm currently in a 5-way group text with some others from the tour, in shock that Groberg is getting the MoH.) The narrative isn't exactly how I would tell it. There were two suicide bombers. They pushed the first guy in such a way that the blast was channeled away from most of the patrol (which was canalized on a city street) and it neutralized the second bomber. No doubt without Groberg's actions more soldiers would have died that day. Even after he flew across the road, he got back up with no skin on his arms and started trying to help people.

It was a shitty day. The look on COL Mingus' face when we told him his CSM didn't make it will stick with me forever. The fact that the god damn Air Force Liason officer (a pilot) decided to pick that day to leave JAAF and go on a patrol (obviously one of the very few in his career) bothers me. The worry that COL Walrath would lose his leg hung over us for weeks to come. A cook along for the ride as an "extra body" concealed his own injuries so he could help the wounded, at one point carrying a stretcher half a mile while he had a ball bearing sized hole through his calf.


It's weird to read a sanitized Army narrative of it all. It's also worth adding that no one liked Groberg. He was kind of a dick to be honest. A bristly personality that was hard to get along with and he acted like he wore the BDE CDR's rank. But I've got no problem calling him a hero.







Conclusion

- While it is entirely possible that this is a 'con', and someone trying to assume an identity, that seems highly unlikely. They would need intimate details of MAJ Poole's life, and would have had to keep this online persona going for 15+ years (anandtech.com site, 2003 creation date for user profile), including stealing personal photos.
- The basic AKO profile for William J Poole will show immediate links to several pieces of information listed in this slide show, as well as his DA photo is obviously the same person as the twitter/Facebook photos.
- The large majority of the comments on his twitter and reddit featured in this presentation are only from the last 90 days. I have no doubt that the more the comment histories are explored, an increase in derogatory information will be found.
