# TIPS FOR TEACHING WRITING

## 1. ALLOW CHOICES.

Students are much more engaged when writing about something they are interested in or passionate about.

### 2. ENCOURAGE COMFORT.

In my experience, being comfortable while writing helps creativity flow.

## **3. HELP THEM EXPERIMENT.**

Not everyone works best cycling through the same process. Some may prefer to knock out an entire piece & revise at the end, while others may want to revise as they go.

#### 4. WRITE WITH THEM. You won't get it unless you do it.

## 5. HAVE EMPATHY.

Writing is challenging, frustrating, & can feel soul-crushing at times. But you already knew that (see #4).

## 6. DON'T OVERSCAFFOLD.

Those graphic organizers & your constant support (while wellintentioned) can often detract from students finding their own voices.

## 7. FOCUS ON THE BEAUTY.

Writing is a beautiful expression of voice. Tell them, show them, & help them discover it for themselves.
