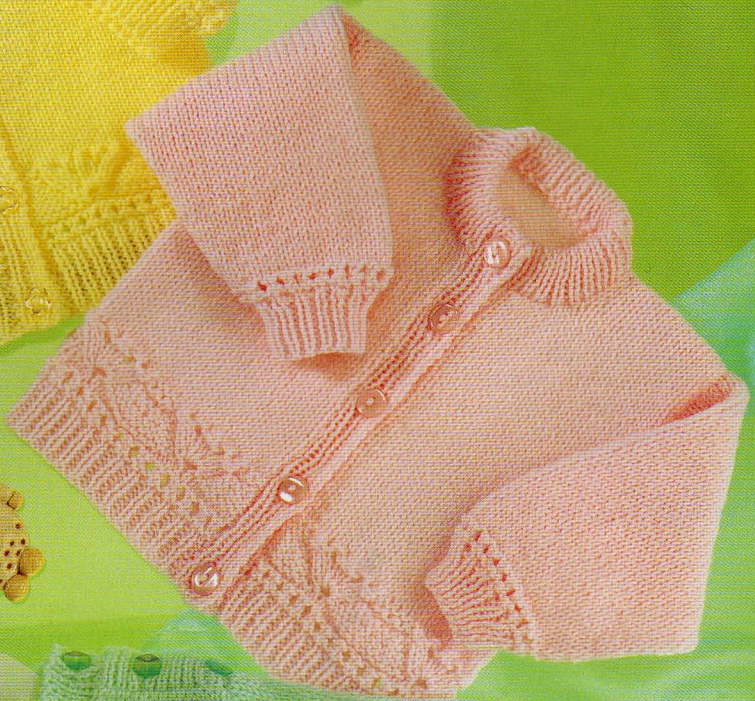

MATERIALS

1 Pair of 4mm (UK8 - USA6) Knitting Needles.
1 3¼mm (UK10 - USA3) 80cm Circular Needle.
Stitch Holders.

5 Buttons for Round Neck Cardigan.
4 Buttons for V Neck Cardigan.
6 Buttons for Sweater.

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm, (4in) over stocking stitch on 4mm needles or the size required to give correct tension.

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

ABBREVIATIONS

2nd Row. Knit.

3rd Row. K1, * yfwd, k2tog, rep from * to last 0 [1:0:1:0:1] sts, kO [1:0:1:0:1].

4th and 5th Rows. Knit.

6th Row. Purl.

7th Row. P11 [10:9:8:6:6], (p1, k1) 3 times all into next st, * p12, (p1, k1) 3 times all into next st, rep from * to last 11 [10:9:8:6:6] sts, p11 [10:9:8:6:6].

8th Row. K11 [10:9:8:6:6], p6, * k12, p6, rep from * to last 11 [10:9:8:6:6] sts, k11 [10:9:8:6:6].

9th Row. P11 [10:9:8:6:6], k6, * p12, k6, rep from * to last 11 [10:9:8:6:6] sts, p11 [10:9:8:6:6].

10th Row. As 8th row.

11th Row. P5 [4:3:2:0:0], (p2tog) twice, p2, (k2, yfwd) twice, k2, * p2, (p2tog) 4 times, p2, (k2, yfwd) twice, k2, rep from * to last 11 [10:9:8:6:6] sts, p2, (p2tog) twice, p5 [4:3:2:0:0].

12th Row. K9 [8:7:6:4:4], p8, * k8, p8, rep from * to last 9 [8:7:6:4:4] sts, k9 [8:7:6:4:4].

13th Row. P5 [4:3:2:0:0], (p2tog) twice, (k2tog, yfwd, k1, yfwd) twice, k2tog, * (p2tog) 4 times, (k2tog, yfwd, k1, yfwd) twice, k2tog, rep from * to last 9 [8:7:6:4:4] sts, (p2tog) twice, p5 [4:3:2:0:0].

14th Row. K7 [6:5:4:2:2], p9, * k4, p9, rep from * to last 7 [6:5:4:2:2] sts, k7 [6:5:4:2:2].

Proceed as follows:-

1st Row. Knit to end inc 0 [0:0:1:0:0] sts in centre of row and dec 0 [1:0:0:0:1] sts in centre of row.

75 [85:97:109:117:129] sts.

2nd Row. Purl.

3rd Row. Knit.

4th Row. Purl.

3rd and 4th rows will now be referred to as st-st (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until work measures 8 [9:11:13:17:20]cm, (3 [3½:4¼:5¾:6½:8]in), ending with a ws row.

Divide for Fronts and Back

Next Row. Knit and slip 17 [20:23:26:28:31] sts onto a stitch holder for right front, knit and slip 41 [45:51:57:61:67] sts onto a stitch holder for back and knit rem 17 [20:23:26:28:31] sts. ***

LEFT FRONT

Working on these 17 [20:23:26:28:31] stş only proceed as follows:-

Next Row. Purl.

Cont until armhole measures 6 [7:7:8:9:10]cm, (2½ [2¾:2¾:3:3½:4]in), ending with a rs row.

Shape Neck

Next Row. Cast off 2 [3:4:4:5:5] sts, purl to end. 15 [17:19:22:23:26] sts.

** Work 5 [5:7:7:7:7] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row. 12 [14:15:18:19:22] sts.

Cont without shaping until left front measures 10 [11:12:13:14:16]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6¼]in), ending with a ws row. Cast off.

BACK

With ws facing, rejoin yarn to 41 [45:51:57:61:67] sts left on a stitch holder for back and proceed as follows:-

Next Row. Purl.

Cont until armholes measure 10 [11:12:13:14:16]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6¼]in).

Circle the size you wish to make

Each garment can be worked with long or short sleeves.

ROUND NECK CARDIGAN

FRONTS AND BACK

(Worked in one piece to armholes)

Using 3¼mm needles cast on 89 [99:111:121:131:143] sts.

1st Row. * K1, p1, rep from * to last st, k1.

2nd Row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as 1x1 rib.

3rd Row. (Buttonhole row) rib 3, cast off 2 sts, rib to end.

4th Row. Rib to last 3 sts, cast on 2 sts, rib 3.

Work 3 [3:5:5:5:5] rows more in rib.

Next Row. Rib and slip first 7 sts onto a stitch holder, rib to last 7 sts inc 0 [1:0:1:0:1] sts in centre of row, slip rem 7 sts onto a stitch holder.

75 [86:97:108:117:130] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

1st Row. Knit.

5½:6¼]in), ending with a ws row.
Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

With ws facing, rejoin yarn to 17 [20:23:26:28:31] sts left on a stitch holder for right front and proceed as follows:-
Next Row. Purl.

Cont until armhole measures 6 [7:7:8:9:10]cm, (2½ [2¾:2¾:3:3½:4]in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Neck

Next Row. Cast off 2 [3:4:4:5:5] sts, knit to end. 15 [17:19:22:23:26] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Complete from ** as given for Left Front.

LONG SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 3¼mm needles cast on 25 [27:29:31:33:35] sts, work 7 [7:9:9:9:9] rows in 1x1 rib.

Next Row. Rib 2 [3:4:5:6:7], pick up loop between last and next st and work into the back of this loop (this will now be referred to as m1), (rib 3, m1) 7 times, rib 2 [3:4:5:6:7]. 33 [35:37:39:41:43] sts. Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

** 1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Knit.

3rd Row. K1, * yfwd, k2tog, rep from * to end.

4th Row. Knit. **

Working in st-st (throughout) inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row to 43 [49:53:57:61:69] sts.

Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 14 [15:16:19:21:25]cm, (5½ [6:6¼:7½:8¼:9¾]in), or length required, ending with a ws row.
Cast off.

SHORT SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 3¼mm needles cast on 41 [45:47:49:51:53] sts, work 7 [7:9:9:9:9] rows in 1x1 rib.

Next Row. Rib 9 [4:3:3:3:4], pick up loop between last and next st and work into the back of this loop (this will now be referred to as m1), (rib 22 [12:8:6:5:3], m1) 1 [3:5:7:9:15] times, rib 10 [5:4:4:3:4]. 43 [49:53:57:61:69] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and work from ** to ** as given for Long Sleeves.

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until sleeve measures 6 [7:8:9:10:11]cm, (2½ [2¾:3:3½:4:4¼]in), ending with a ws row. Cast off.

LEFT FRONT BORDER

With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles cast on 1 st (cast on st to be used for sewing front border to front), rib across 7 sts left on a stitch holder. 8 sts.

1st Row. (P1, k1) 4 times.

1st row sets rib.

Cont in rib until border is of sufficient length to go up front, ending with a ws row.

Leave these 8 sts on a stitch holder.

Mark the position for 5 buttons, the top one to be placed in 4th and 5th rows of neckband, the bottom one in 3rd and 4th

rows and the other 3 evenly spaced between these two.

RIGHT FRONT BORDER

With ws facing, using 3¼mm needles cast on 1 st (cast on st to be used for sewing front border to front) rib across 7 sts left on a stitch holder. 8 sts.

1st Row. (K1, p1) 4 times.

1st row sets rib.

Working buttonholes as set to correspond with markers cont until border is of sufficient length to go up front, ending with a ws row.

Leave these 8 sts on a stitch holder.

NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams. With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles work across 8 sts left on a stitch holder for right front border as follows:- (k1, p1) 3 times, k2tog, pick up and knit 12 [13:16:16:17:19] sts evenly along right side of neck, 17 [17:21:21:23:23] sts from back of neck, 12 [13:16:16:17:19] sts evenly along left side of neck and work across 8 sts left on a stitch holder for left front border as follows:- k2tog, (p1, k1) 3 times. 55 [57:67:67:71:75] sts. Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work 15 rows working buttonholes as set in 4th and 5th rows and 12th and 13th rows. Cast off loosely in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Fold sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds to shoulder seams sew sleeves in position for approximately 10 [11:12:13:14:15]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6]in) from top of shoulder. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew front borders in position (using cast on sts). Fold neckband in half onto ws and slip stitch loosely in position. Work round top buttonhole. Sew on buttons. Pin out garment to the measurement given on front page. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

V NECK CARDIGAN FRONTS AND BACK

(Worked in one piece to armholes)
Work as given for Fronts and Back of Round Neck Cardigan to ***.

LEFT FRONT

Working on these 17 [20:23:26:28:31] sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row. Purl.

** Shape Neck

Work 17 [21:22:22:33:33] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th [4th:3rd:3rd:4th:4th] row.

12 [14:15:18:19:22] sts.

Cont without shaping until left front measures 10 [11:12:13:14:16]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6¼]in), ending with a ws row. Cast off.

BACK

Work as given for Back of Round Neck Cardigan.

RIGHT FRONT

With ws facing, rejoin yarn to 17 [20:23:26:28:31] sts left on a stitch holder for right front and proceed as follows:-

Next Row. Purl.

Complete from ** as given for Left Front.

LONG SLEEVES (Both alike)

Work as given for Long Sleeves of Round Neck Cardigan.

SHORT SLEEVES (Both alike)

Work as given for Short Sleeves of Round Neck Cardigan.

LEFT FRONT BORDER

With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles cast on 1 st (cast on st to be used for sewing front border to front), rib across 7 sts left on a stitch holder. 8 sts.

1st Row. (P1, k1) 4 times.

1st row sets rib.

Cont in rib until border is of sufficient length to go up front and halfway across back of neck, ending with a ws row.

Cast off in rib.

Mark the position for 4 buttons, the top one to be placed 2cm, (¾in) below 1st front dec, the bottom one in 3rd and 4th rows and the other 2 evenly spaced between these two.

RIGHT FRONT BORDER

With ws facing, using 3¼mm needles cast on 1 st (cast on st to be used for sewing front border to front) rib across 7 sts left on a stitch holder. 8 sts.

1st Row. (K1, p1) 4 times.

1st row sets rib.

Working buttonholes as set to correspond with markers cont until border is of sufficient length to go up front and halfway across back of neck, ending with a ws row. Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Fold sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds to shoulder seams, sew sleeves in position for approximately 10 [11:12:13:14:15]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6]in) from top of shoulder. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew front borders in position (using cast on sts). Sew on buttons. Pin out garment to the measurement given on front page. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

SWEATER

BACK

Using 3¼mm needles cast on 41 [45:51:55:61:67] sts.

1st Row. * K1, p1, rep from * to last st, k1.

2nd Row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as 1x1 rib.

Work in 1x1 rib for 4cm, (1½in), ending with a rs row.

Next Row. Rib to end inc 1 st in centre of row for 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only.

41 [45:52:56:62:67] sts.
Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

1st Row. Knit.
2nd Row. Knit.
3rd Row. K1, * yfwd, k2tog, rep from * to last 0 [0:1:1:1:0] sts, k0 [0:1:1:1:0].
4th and 5th Rows. Knit.
6th Row. Purl.
7th Row. P7 [9:6:8:11:7], (p1, k1) 3 times all into next st, * p12, (p1, k1) 3 times all into next st, rep from * to last 7 [9:6:8:11:7] sts, p7 [9:6:8:11:7].
8th Row. K7 [9:6:8:11:7], p6, * k12, p6, rep from * to last 7 [9:6:8:11:7] sts, k7 [9:6:8:11:7].
9th Row. P7 [9:6:8:11:7], k6, * p12, k6, rep from * to last 7 [9:6:8:11:7] sts, p7 [9:6:8:11:7].
10th Row. As 8th row.

11th Row. P1 [3:0:2:5:1], (p2tog) twice, p2, (k2, yfwd) twice, k2, * p2, (p2tog) 4 times, p2, (k2, yfwd) twice, rep from * to last 7 [9:6:8:11:7] sts, p2, (p2tog) twice, p1 [3:0:2:5:1].
12th Row. K5 [7:4:6:9:5], p8, * k8, p8, rep from * to last 5 [7:4:6:9:5] sts, k5 [7:4:6:9:5].
13th Row. P1 [3:0:2:5:1], (p2tog) twice, (k2tog, yfwd, k1, yfwd) twice, k2tog, * (p2tog) 4 times, (k2tog, yfwd, k1, yfwd) twice, k2tog, rep from * to last 5 [7:4:6:9:5] sts, (p2tog) twice, p1 [3:0:2:5:1].
14th Row. K3 [5:2:4:7:3], p9, * k4, p9, rep from * to last 3 [5:2:4:7:3] sts, k3 [5:2:4:7:3].

Proceed as follows:-
1st Row. Knit to end dec 1 st in centre of row for 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only. 41 [45:52:56:62:67] sts.

2nd Row. Purl.
3rd Row. Knit.
4th Row. Purl.
3rd and 4th rows will now be referred to as st-st (stocking stitch).
Working in st-st (throughout) cont until back measures 12 [14:16:19:24:29]cm, (4¼ [5½:6¼:7½:9½:11½]in), ending with a ws row. **
Work 4 [4:8:8:8] rows more.

Shape Neck
Next Row. K15 [17:18:21:22:25], turn, leave rem 26 [28:33:36:39:42] sts on a stitch holder.
Working on these 15 [17:18:21:22:25] sts only proceed as follows:-
Next Row. Purl.
Work 3 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in

every row. 12 [14:15:18:19:22] sts.
Next Row. P2 [3:3:4:3:5], pick up loop between last and next st and work into the back of this loop (this will now be referred to as m1), (p4 [4:3:5:4:6], m1) 2 [2:3:2:3:2] times, p2 [3:3:4:4:5]. 15 [17:19:21:23:25] sts.

Shoulder Edging
Change to 3¼mm needles and starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work 6 rows.
Cast off in rib.
With rs facing, working on rem 26 [28:33:36:39:42] sts, slip 11 [11:15:15:17:17] sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 15 [17:18:21:22:25] sts and knit to end.
Complete to match first side of neck.

FRONT
Work as given for Back to **. 41 [45:51:57:61:67] sts.

Shape Neck
Next Row. K15 [17:19:22:23:26], turn, leave rem 26 [28:32:35:38:41] sts on a stitch holder.
Working on these 15 [17:19:22:23:26] sts only proceed as follows:-
** Next Row. Purl.
Work 5 [5:7:7:7] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row. 12 [14:15:18:19:22] sts.
Work 2 [2:4:4:4] rows without shaping.
Next Row. P2 [3:3:4:3:5], m1, (p4 [4:3:5:4:6], m1) 2 [2:3:2:3:2] times, p2 [3:3:4:4:5]. 15 [17:19:21:23:25] sts.

Shoulder Edging
Change to 3¼mm needles and starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work 3 rows. **
Next Row. Rib 3 [4:5:6:7:8], cast off 1 st, rib 4 [5:6:7:8:9], cast off 1 st, rib 4.
Next Row. Rib 5, cast on 1 st, rib 5 [6:7:8:9:10], cast on 1 st, rib 3 [4:5:6:7:8].
Work 3 rows in rib.
Cast off in rib.
With rs facing, working on rem 26 [28:32:35:38:41] sts slip 11 [11:13:13:15:15] sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 15 [17:19:22:23:26] sts and knit to end.
Work from ** to **.
Next Row. Rib 5, cast off 1 st, rib 4 [5:6:7:8:9], cast off 1 st, rib 2 [3:4:5:6:7].
Next Row. Rib 3 [4:5:6:7:8], cast on 1 st, rib 5 [6:7:8:9:10], cast on 1 st, rib 5.
Work 3 rows in rib.

Cast off in rib.

LONG SLEEVES (Both alike)
Work as given for Long Sleeves of Round Neck Cardigan.

SHORT SLEEVES (Both alike)
Work as given for Short Sleeves of Round Neck Cardigan.

BACK NECKBAND
With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles starting at right side shoulder edging, pick up and knit 6 sts evenly along right shoulder edging, 4 sts evenly along right side of back neck, 11 [11:15:15:17:17] sts left on a stitch holder at back of neck, 4 sts evenly along left side of back neck and 6 sts evenly along left shoulder edging. 31 [31:35:35:37:37] sts.
Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work 6 rows. Cast off in rib.

FRONT NECKBAND
With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles starting at left shoulder edging, pick up and knit 6 sts evenly along left shoulder edging, 9 [9:13:13:13:13] sts evenly along left side of neck, 11 [11:13:13:15:15] sts left on a stitch holder at front of neck, 9 [9:13:13:13:13] sts evenly along right side of neck and 6 sts evenly along right shoulder edging. 41 [41:51:51:53:53] sts.
Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work 2 rows.
Next Row. Rib 4, cast off 1 st, rib to last 6 sts, cast off 1 st, rib 3.
Next Row. Rib 4, cast on 1 st, rib to last 4 sts, cast on 1 st, rib 4.
Work 2 rows in rib.
Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP
Place back shoulder edgings under front shoulder edgings and join together at side edges. Fold sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds to shoulder seams, sew sleeves in position for approximately 10 [11:12:13:14:15]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6]in), from top of shoulder. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons. Pin out garment to measurement given on front page. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
