

RULES AND REGULATIONS

OF A DRAW DURING „INDEPENDENCE DAY 2018” EVENT

§1 - Definitions

1. Organiser – an organiser of the „Independence Day 2018” event – PolishVACC.
2. Event Staff – a person who is responsible for event coordination.
3. Task – one of the tasks described in the paragraph 4.
4. Sponsor – company which provides us with the prizes.

§2 – Criteria

1. To compete in the draw you must to fulfill criterias mentioned below:
 - You must have valid VATSIM ID.
 - You must be 13 years of older.
 - You must fully complete one of the task.
 - You must fill the application to the draw.
2. All fields in the application must be filled with correct data.

§3 – Privacy Policy

1. We are collecting your data in the application form. We only require your:
 - Name and surname
 - VATSIM ID
 - Email address
2. All others data are not required by us. Please do not share other data.
3. Administrator of your data:
 - PolishVACC (official VATEUD VACC representing VATSIM in Poland)
4. Your data will be transferred to our sponsors only if you win a draw.
5. We will only transfer your name and surname and email address to make a contact between sponsor and you possible.

7. Your data will be collected for a draw purposes only.

§4 – Tasks

1. Event is divided for 4 tasks. Pilots have to fully complete one task and fill an application to take part in the lottery.
2. Task descriptions:
 - **Sunset landing** – pilots have to land on **Warsaw (EPWA) or Modlin (EPMO)** airports between **14:00 UTC and 16:00 UTC** on November, 10th 2018, while connected to the VATSIM network. At this timeframe aircraft should be on ground (land on the runway).
 - **Night operations** – pilots have to complete one return-leg from and to **Warsaw (EPWA)** airport between **23:00 UTC** on November, 10th 2018 and **04:00 UTC** on November, 11th 2018, while connected to the VATSIM network. At this timeframe aircraft should be on ground (land on the runway or takeoff from the runway).
 - **First wave of departures** – pilots have to depart from **Warsaw (EPWA) or Modlin (EPMO)** airport between **04:00 UTC and 07:00 UTC** on November, 11th 2018, while connected to the VATSIM network. At this timeframe aircraft should be on ground (takeoff from the runway).
 - **Complete turnaround** – pilots have to complete one turnaround flight to **Warsaw (EPWA) or Modlin (EPMO)** airports between **11:00 UTC and 21:00 UTC** on November, 10th 2018 or between **07:00 UTC and 11:00 UTC** on November, 11th 2018, while connected to VATSIM network. At this timeframe aircraft should be on ground (land on the runway or takeoff from the runway).

3. Definitions explanation:
 - **Return-leg** – flight from EPWA to random destination and flight from the same destination back to EPWA. Note that your destination can't be: EPWA, EPMO or EPLL. The flight must be flown via Instrument Flight Rules.
 - **Turnaround** – flight from random destination to EPWA or EPMO and back from EPWA or EPMO to the same or other destination as your first departure. Note that your first departure airport can't be: EPWA, EPMO or EPLL. The flight must be flown via Instrument Flight Rules. If you land on EPWA you must depart from EPWA for the second sector. If you land on EPMO you must depart from EPMO for the second sector.
4. Completion of the task by the pilots will be verified with the pilot application and VATSIM Germany Statistic Center site (<http://stats.vatsim-germany.org>).

§5 – Regulations of the draw

1. Organiser will perform a draw during live stream on the PolishVACC Facebook site (<http://facebook.com/plvacc>). Terms of the draw will be explained before draw.
2. Winners will be announced on the PolishVACC Facebook page and PolishVACC Forums (<http://forum.pl-vacc.org.pl>). In the announcement your name and surname will be provided.
3. In case you are announced as the winner, please send private message to the PolishVACC on the facebook or via email (send email to accpl4@pl-vacc.org.pl).
4. Winner will be selected randomly from all confirmed applications.
5. Applications will be confirmed before draw. We will confirm if pilot successfully completed tasks and all other criterias are met.
6. In case of the only one valid application for a task, draw in this category will be passed over and the pilot with only one valid application announced as the winner.
7. In case of no valid application for a task, draw in this category will be passed over and the prize will be returned to the sponsor.
8. If winner will not attempt to contact with PolishVACC within 7 days from the winner announcement, new draw will be run.
