Personally came [REDACTED] who on oath says that to the best of his/her personal knowledge and belief, Clarence Brown did, on Jun 06, 2020 at approximately 04:00 PM in RICHMOND County, GEORGIA, commit the offense of: **CRUELTY TO CHILDREN IN THE FIRST DEGREE - Felony** in violation of O.C.G.A 16-5-70, a **Felony** under the laws of the state of GEORGIA, in that said accused on the above stated date and time, **did maliciously cause a child under the age of 18, [REDACTED] cruel and excessive mental pain by forcing him to listen to the cruel and excessive punishment of Derrick Camp when he struck him multiple times with an extension cord, phone charging cord, and small tree branches all over his body, the accused also struck him in his stomach with a closed fist causing him to urinate on himself, and forced the victim to do military-style squats while holding a book, and push-ups until he collapsed.
