Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



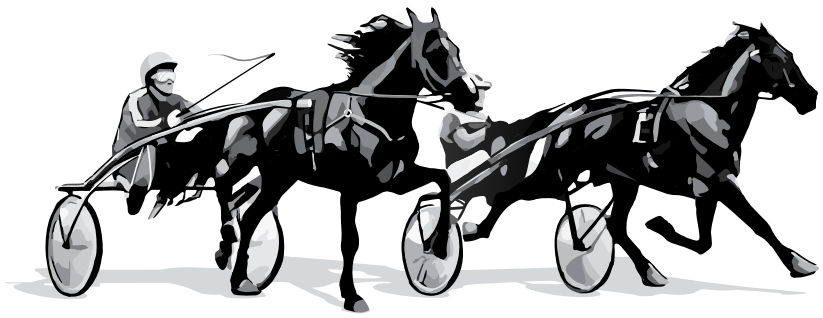
Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

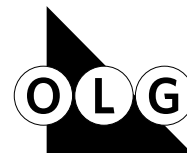
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

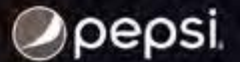

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#3 ELBE turned in a solid performance in her lifetime debut last week when she finished third after getting a difficult trip. She tried to move forward for position off the gate but got stuck three-wide to the first turn and was then taken back to seventh, where she sat for most of the mile. This mare was not asked to trot forward until the final turn and rolled wide for clearance before entering the stretch. She came her back-half in 57.2 and was moving best at the wire, closing in quickly on the runner-up who got a much more favorable journey. Elbe produced an impressive qualifier going into that event and now gets a much better starting spot this time around. She gets our top honors to kick off the card.

#4 JULA MAGICIAN was the runner-up in this class last week after marching to the lead before the halfway point before Dealin With Dewey charged past in the stretch. It was a decent effort and one that this colt can build on but the one above was moving much more impressively under the wire. Using underneath.

#2 PAINTED LAND is making his three-year-old debut and does so after moving to the barn of Ben Baillargeon. He only picked up one cheque in three tries as a rookie but produced a decent qualifier on June 4th in preparation for this effort. This colt trotted his final quarter in 29.3 to finish second to Splash Of Halo and now gets lasix for the first time. We have seen these connections work wonders with these types before and he should not be dismissed.

#7 TEST YOUR MAGIC raced twice at Pocono Downs in May and finished third in his most recent effort three weeks ago. This son of Kadabra showed speed from the outside post in his lifetime debut and will likely be forwardly placed by McNair in this spot. He can get a piece of it.

#4 ROYALTY DEAL moves up the class ladder tonight but does so off a victory of the easiest variety in NW3 last week. She was sent out to the early lead and made every call a winning one to score in 1:54.4 under a hand drive to MacDonell. This mare made nearly \$160,000 last season and notched two victories at the OSS Gold level, as well as finished third beaten a nose in the Super Final. This will mark her second start on lasix and if she maintains or progresses off her latest, she will be tough to catch in a field rich with talent.

#1 SHESWILDNFREE travelled south of the border to make three starts during the shutdown. She was an easy winner at the Meadowlands on April 30th but then followed it up with a fourth-place finish and then made a break in her latest to blow up at 30 cents to the dollar at Pocono Downs. This mare comes into this off nearly a month but like the one above, has a maturity edge over most of the other contenders in the contest. Using underneath.

#3 HAWAII only missed by a nose in an OSS Gold event last season and then dominated her foes by sweeping the Harvest Series. She stayed on the pylons last week in the first start of her three-year-old season and never had a chance the way the race unfolded. This filly will likely be handled more aggressively this time around and should not be easily dismissed.

#5 IMEXTRASPECIAL was not asked to do much in her first start of her sophomore season last week. She got away fifth and went an even mile when the leader up front got the benefit of a middle-half of 59.1. This filly might make a better account of herself tonight.

This 11-time winner comes into this with a decent looking qualifying effort under his belt, where he came home in 27.1 to trot his mile in 1:56.4 with no urging from Christoforou to the wire. He raced well in his last two over the surface and is one of the key winning chances in here.

#8 MEMO surged to an impressive victory in the stretch last at this level last week after sitting a perfect two-hole trip. He scored going away in 1:54 flat and should be pointed towards the front-end once again by Doug McNair. This 12-time winner has a big chance to repeat but we will give the one above a whirl on top.

#5 DONATOVER went a difficult first-over journey in this class last week in his first start for Don Lindsey. He stuck around to finish third but was no match for the winner, who trotted away from everyone in the stretch. This 19-time winner loses Christoforou to our top selection but picks up a suitable replacement in Bob McClure. He is not without a chance and should get another piece of it this time around.

#3 O NARUTAC PERFETTO had to return to the races after an eight-month hiatus in the Preferred last week and never had a chance against that difficult group of trotters. He gets some major class relief tonight and picked up pieces at this level last season, along with a dead heat victory on August 17th. This 25-time winner figures to be motoring late and can work his way onto the bottom end of the exotics.

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

Smoking Regulations

The Government of Ontario is committed to improving the health of residents through the implementation of the *Smoke-Free Ontario Act*. Recent changes to the Act, which came into effect on January 1, 2015, further restrict the use of tobacco products in restaurants and bar patios. Smoking is now prohibited in all areas where food is served or sold or offered for consumption or in areas that are operated in conjunction with an area where food and drink is served or sold.

The City of Toronto has also enacted restrictions on smoking in public places by requiring that smoking is not permitted within a 9 metre radius of an entrance or exit to a public building.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

HOW TO BET

Please call your bets to a teller in the following manner: Amount of base bet, type of bet, horse numbers.
Examples: \$3.00 to Win, number 7; \$5.00 Daily Doubles, 6 and 4, 7 and 5.
The minimum amount for a single bet in any pool other than Superfect, Pick 3 and Pick 4 is \$1.00.

TYPES OF BETS

The following types of bets may be made on each race:
WIN - You must select the winner of the race.
PLACE - Your horse must finish first, second.
SHOW - Your horse must finish first, second or third.
The following "feature" bets are available on one or more races as indicated in the program:
DAILY DOUBLE - Select the winner of two consecutive races for the races designated as the Daily Double events. This bet must be placed before the first race.
EXACTOR - Select the first two horses in exact order of finish.
TRIACTOR - Select the first three horses in exact order of finish.
SUPERFACTA - Select the first four horses in exact order of finish.
PICK 3 - Select the winner of three consecutive races for the races designated as Pick 3 events.
PICK 4 - Select the winners of four consecutive races for the races designated as Pick 4 events.

BOXES AND WHEELS

By "boxing" or "wheeling", you can combine several bets on one ticket, as follows:

DAILY DOUBLE

Wheel one "key" horse in the 1st race with several horses in the 2nd race or several horses in the 1st race with one horse in the second race - your ticket is cashable if the key horse and one of your choices in the other race are both winners.
Example \$1.00 Daily Double Wheel, number 3 "on top" with a nine horse field, cost is \$9.00 (9 combinations)

EXACTOR BOXES & WHEELS

Box two, three or more horses - your ticket is cashable if two of the boxed horses finish first and second.
Examples: \$2.00 Exactor Box, 3 and 5 - cost is \$4.00 (2 combinations)
\$3.00 Exactor Box, 2, 4, 6 - cost is \$18.00 (6 combinations)
\$1.00 Exactor Box, 1, 3, 5, 8 - cost is \$12.00 (12 combinations)
Wheel one horse to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if that horse finishes in the selected position, -- either first (on top) or second (on bottom).
Example: \$1.00 Exactor Wheel, 3 "on top" - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$8.00.

TRIACTOR BOXES AND WHEELS

Box three, four or more horses - your ticket is cashable if three of the boxed horses finish 1st, 2nd and 3rd, in any order.
Examples: \$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 5 - cost is \$6.00
\$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5 - cost is \$24.00
\$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 - cost is \$60.00
\$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 - cost is \$120.00

SUPERFACTA BOXES AND WHEELS

Box four or more horses - your ticket is cashable if four of the boxed horses finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in any order.
Examples: \$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5 - cost is \$24.00
\$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 - cost is \$120.00
\$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 - cost is \$360.00

Key Horse Bet also available - Example: \$1.00 Triactor Key, number 4 with numbers, 5, 6 and 9 - cost is \$6.00 (6 combinations). The ticket is cashable if number 4 (the "Key" horse) wins and two of the numbers, 5, 6 and 9 finish second and third.

Key horse plus 2 horses = 2 combinations;
Key horse plus 4 horses = 12 combinations;
Key horse plus 5 horses = 20 combinations; etc.
Wheel two horses to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if the two specified horses finished in the selected positions.
Example: \$1.00 Triactor Wheel 2 - 6 - "all" - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$7.00 (7 combinations). Variations: all - 2 - 6, 2 - all - 6.
Wheel one horse to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if that horse finishes in the selected position:
Examples: \$1.00 Triactor Wheel, 5 - all - all - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$56.00 (56 combinations).
\$2.00 Triactor Wheel, all - 8 - all - with an 8-horse field, cost is \$84.00 (42 combinations).

PARTIAL WHEELS

If you don't want to include all horses in a wheel bet, specify "Part Wheel" and call the horses's numbers individually.
Examples: \$1.00 Exactor Part Wheel, 7 with 1, 2, 4 and 9 - cost is \$4.00 (4 combinations) and the ticket is cashable if number 7 wins and any of numbers 1, 2, 4 or 9 finishes second.
\$2.00 Triactor Part Wheel, 3 with 8 with 1, 2, 4 and 9 - cost is \$8.00 (4 combinations) and the ticket is cashable if number 3 wins and number 8 finishes second and any of numbers, 1, 2, 4 or 9 finishes 3rd.

PLEASE NOTE

When calling **Box** or **Wheel** bets to a teller, specify the amount of the base bet - **for example:** \$1.00 Triactor Box, \$2.00 Exactor Wheel - and not the total cost of the wager.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
