ASK ME ANYTHING SUMMARY

MediBloc had an AMA session in their official telegram group on 15/03/2018 at 10AM (UTC +9). Dr. Allen Wookyun Kho, co founder of MediBloc was attending to answer the questions.

For those who missed it, we made a list of the questions which were asked. We would like to thank Dr.Allen to attend this AMA and wish him and the team the best in the future development!

Q: How is the project going?

A: We are doing great working on the development, both business and software and the things are going as planned. As you all may know, medical industry is really conservative, so it takes more me than other industry but we keep making progress for sure.

Q: Is the SDK still scheduled to drop in May?

A: Yes, we believe so.

Q: I'm not as familiar with the healthcare space in Asia. Do you expect it to be a market that is more amenable to what you are trying to do vs. the market in, for example, the US?

A: Definitely. That's one of the big reasons why we start from Asia.

Q: What do you think the primary benefit will be for MediBloc holders and users within the MediBloc ecosystem?

A: As we mentioned in our recent post, message from MediBloc , we think that the value of MED reflects the value of the whole MediBloc ecosystem. In that sense, the value the MediBloc platform will make, will return to the holders in the end.

Q: Will I be able to spend MediBloc tokens on medical expenses?

A: That should be one of the use cases of MED.

Q: Is it safe to say Medibloc will act as a tollway for all medical info being passed along the Medibloc ecosystem? (i.e. research, insurance, etc.)

A: kind of, but not really since MediBloc is not requiring money for all kinds of transaction.

Q: Some are concerned about the lack of activity on github. Is the reason because you are holding your cards closely while developing your product?

A: Good question. We also mentioned about this in our recent post. Although we keep making progress, opening all our in all development result to the public may make some unnecessary misunderstanding.

Q: How are the relationships with Your local government and are they supporting MediBloc project at the moment?

A: We keep communicating with our government about the system we build.

Q: How will MediBloc compete in the health care industry against tech giants

by using blockchain technology?

A: I think we don't need to compete with them. MediBloc platform is like an infrastructure to support the healthcare data sharing. The tech giants are all trying to make services to make money, not the infrastructure. You see, MediBloc is like an internet.

Q: Some people on here have been wondering - what happens during emergency situations? Is some core available to healthcare systems while other info belongs completely to the patients. Also, what happens in emergency situations regarding access to info when the patient is incapacitated?

A: As a patient, you can freely choose what information you want to open in case of emergency. And healthcare professionals can access to these very information and the all access history will be recorded in blockchain.

Q: Can you tell me about how I will get my medical data into your platform?

A: There are two kinds of healthcare data; the data made by healthcare professionals and the data made by individuals. The later seems pretty straight forward; data should be made and encrypted with patient's own key and stored in MediBloc platform.

Q: What is medibloc offering that the other medical teams are not? What is the main differences and how are you promoting those points of difference?

A: The concept-wise, there's not that much difference since the things we are planning to do is not something totally new. It's been discussed for more than a decade in medical industry but we believe that we can be the first one who can build the working-system and the actual use case in real world. This is because, I believe that our development team is definitely the best in its kind.

Q: Would MediBloc pay someone in MediBloc tokens to help them apply data science to their data sets?

A: That can be possible if we have lots of data, but the thing is, MediBloc doesn't really have any access to the data stored on the platform.

Q: Right because the individual controls their data?

A: True.

Q: What about awareness in Korea?

A: I can say that we are definitely one of the most well-known blockchain project in Korea at the moment.

Q: How do you think I will be spending my MediBloc 5 years from now?

A: I think we will all living a whole different world, built on top of crypto instead of fiat. I believe that you can freely do whatever you want with MED, not just something in medical industry.
