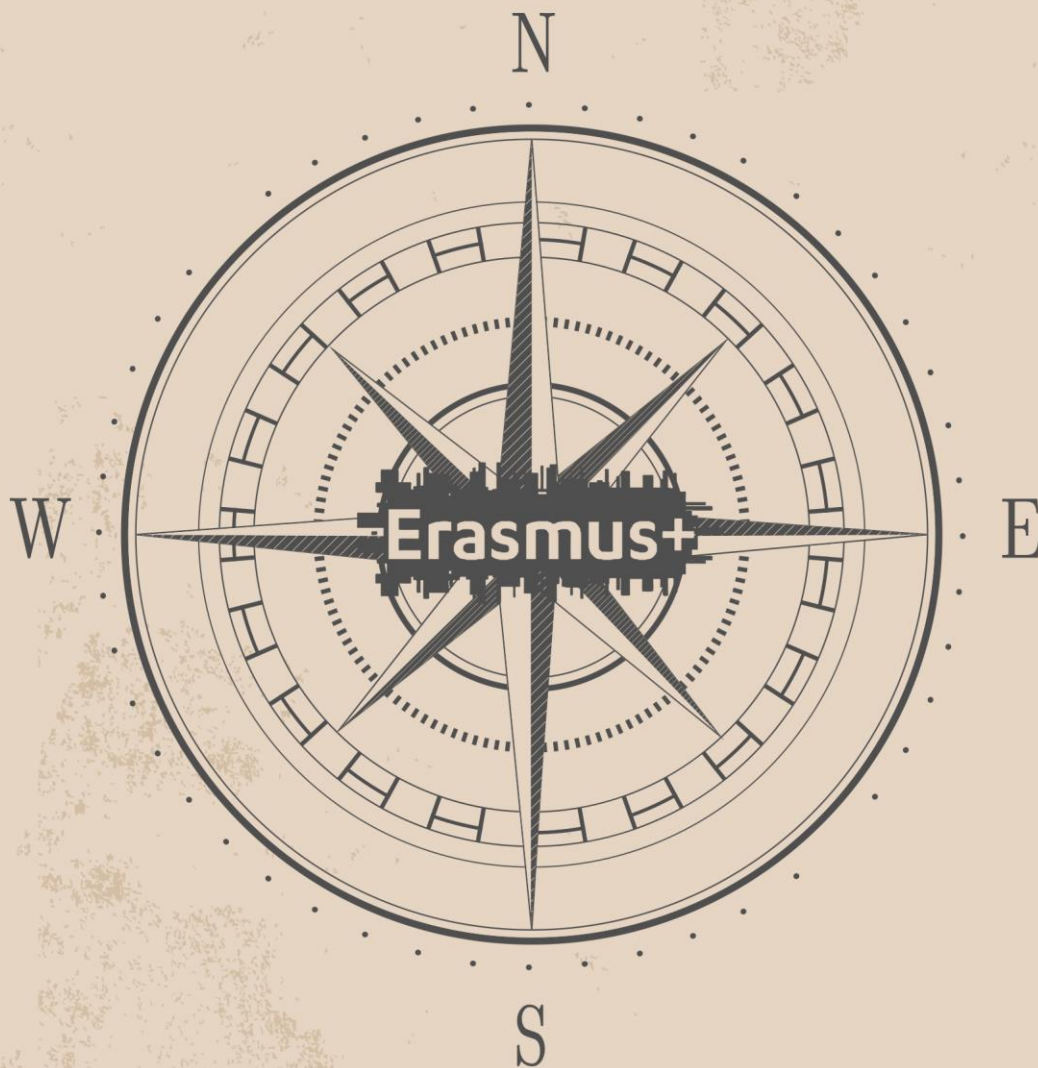

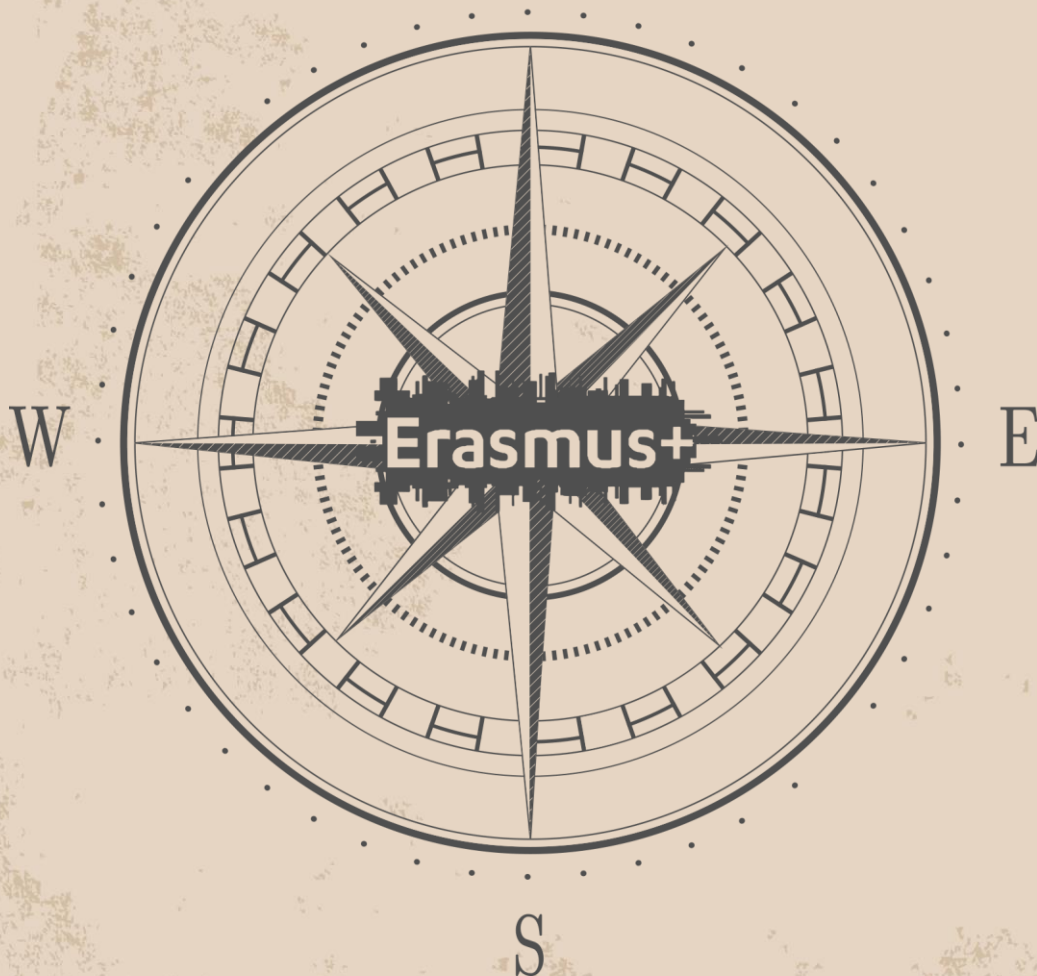


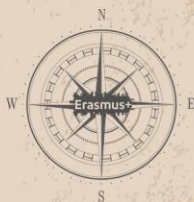

AIM OF PROJECT

To place young people in a multicultural context and in an open space of communication, in order to encourage a curious and communicative attitude in intercultural dialogue.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

- Creating a multicultural and multidisciplinary show/performance/show based on folk dances, contemporary dance, music and reciting poetry in a 7-day international mobility with 55 young people.
- Creating a youth community from 11 European and non-European countries by reinforcing multicultural tolerance and acceptance behaviors among 55 young people from 11 countries, for 7 days as part of a mobility project.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

- To develop the cultural and artistic spirit among 55 young people from 11 countries during the 7 months of the project.
- Encouraging a tolerant and multicultural spirit among 55 young people in 11 countries over the 7 months of the project.
- Improve English language skills among 55 young people from 11 countries over the 7 months of the project.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project is placed in an intercultural environment where so-called borders are contradictory from different points of view. On the one hand, young people are exposed to policies that highlight the existence of these borders and which can encourage resistance to other cultures. On the other hand, the world of



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communication tends towards total openness and cultural globalization due to the free and intense circulation of information over the Internet as well as the relativization of individual identity through virtualization.

The idea of the project is to place young people in a multicultural context and in an open space of communication. This idea responds to the need to encourage a curious and communicative attitude in intercultural dialogue. It is important that such initiatives support young people in clarifying their cultural identity and cultivating a balanced attitude about it.

The need for this project is to understand the multiculturalism and diversity of the world in all its complexity and to develop tolerant attitudes. Thus, the 11 organizations from EU and non-EU countries have set up this project to support members of their organizations to develop multicultural, tolerance and interaction skills with young people from other cultures.

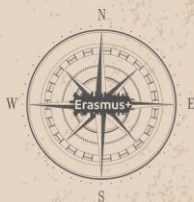
We believe that it is a real need for today's young people to identify and be able to present the essential elements of their own culture as well as to listen and learn about other cultures of the world. This need not only concerns them, but the whole culture they come from, as well as the nature of intercultural and international dialogue.

At the same time, in order to understand the global culture born with the spread of the Internet, the need to physically travel and expose to new, new cultures appears as an essential one. More specifically, the cultural identity of young people is composed not only of what is specific to each culture by differentiation, but also by similarity. Dialogue is strengthened by empathy and by finding common elements, even in the midst of the different. In this respect, direct interaction in a more diverse cultural community is a solution with great potential.

PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

Young people aged 18 - 30 participate in this project following a selection process that will be described in the following sections.

The participants must be willing to actively participate in artistic and creative activities (dance, music, poetry, etc.)

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:

- 55 participants in total

- 5 participants from each country (1 group leader with no age limit and 4 youth participants with age 18-30).

TYPE OF PARTICIPANTS:

Participant (5 persons for each country):

- Minimum age 18 old.

- Maximum age 30 years old.



All participants must be able to easily have a conversation in English language.

Group Leader (1 person for each group):

- Minimum age 25 years old.
- Maximum age 60 years old.

Group leader must be able to speak very good English.

Disadvantaged participants or participants with fewer opportunities should have priority, especially those who would not be able to afford to participate in such projects from their own money and also those who are in risk of social exclusion.

SLEEPING

There will be rooms with 8 beds. You will be sharing rooms, and you will be mixed in the rooms with participants from other countries, but with the same gender.

BODO SMART CAMP @ Bodo Village, Timis County, Romania

PARTICIPATION FEE: €0 (ZERO)

PARTICIPANT PREPARATION:

- Complete registration form.
- Prepare a short presentation about your sending organization.
- Prepare a short (30 minutes) activity for the intercultural evening. This can include songs, dance, games, traditions etc. Must be interactive and fun for other participants to join in. Also please bring some food and drink from your country and a large flag if you have one.



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FOOD / EATING:

We will have food for each person's needs. If you are vegan, vegetarian, lactose intolerant, or if you have any other food requirement, you will have to write it in your application form and we will provide the food that you need.

Breakfast:

Breakfast will be served between 08:00 and 09:30 each day.

Breakfast will be typically Romanian, so it will consist out of cheese, salami, ham, sausages, eggs, tomatoes, cucumbers, coffee, water, milk, juice, biscuits, and jam. Of course, if you have some preferences we can discuss them in the first day and we will try to adapt to your needs.

Lunch:

Everyday lunch out of 2 courses:

Course 1: Soup or Salad

Course 2: Main course (pasta, rice, potatoes, meat, pizza, etc.)

Dinner:

Dinner will include a single course with a main dish. Also, water will be included.

MONEY

The official currency in Romania is RON.

In Timisoara you can find a lot of exchange offices in the city center and also close to the accommodation.

You should bring EURO if possible for you.

Also, you can withdraw RON from the ATMs but you will have to pay a commission.

And, of course, you can pay directly with a credit card in almost every shop or restaurant.

But, the best way is to also bring some EURO cash and change them into RON in Timisoara.

The currency now is:

1 EURO = 4.7 RON





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The weather in Timișoara, in **October** will be between 15 and 25 degrees Celsius.

We will send you updates regarding the weather one week before the mobility.

WHAT TO BRING

Clothes:

- Everyday clothes – shirts, trousers, T-shirts, underwear, socks, etc.
- Comfortable practical shoes
- Boots or shoes for walking out

Toiletries:

- Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, showers gel etc.

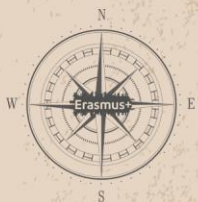
For inter-cultural night:

- Some sweets, alcohol, food, snacks, flag of your country (if possible)
- The venue is equipped with a kitchen in case you want to cook

HEALTH

If you are allergic or have any medical condition, please make sure to bring your medicine with you. Also, you **must absolutely** make travel insurance for travel when you come to Romania.

We never had any incidents, but it is always best to be prepared for any accidents or allergy that you might have.

TRAVELLING

Coming to Timisoara, there are different options that you can choose from.

Each Partner Organization is responsible of finding the most convenient option for their participants.

Because we want to be good coordinators, we would like to offer to help you if you need with some options and maybe even more. For those of you who will fly to Budapest, we can rent a bus or mini-bus and pick you up from there.

Of course, everyone is free to choose how they want to travel. We just want to offer some options to help you out.

The best, easiest and cheapest way of coming to Timisoara is to take an airplane to BUDAPEST AIRPORT (in Hungary) and from there the transport company that we will talk to, will pick you up with a bus / mini-bus.

The cost of the transport for each person from Budapest to Timisoara and from Timisoara to Budapest with the bus will be around 45 euro for one way.

We will discuss this with each Partner Organization after you book the flight tickets because we need to know the exact days and hours of your arrival in Budapest Airport so that we can arrange for everyone to be picked up and travel to Timisoara.

ARRIVING IN BODO VILLAGE:

The host organization CSYD will provide a BUS from Timișoara to Bodo Smart Camp in Bodo village.
