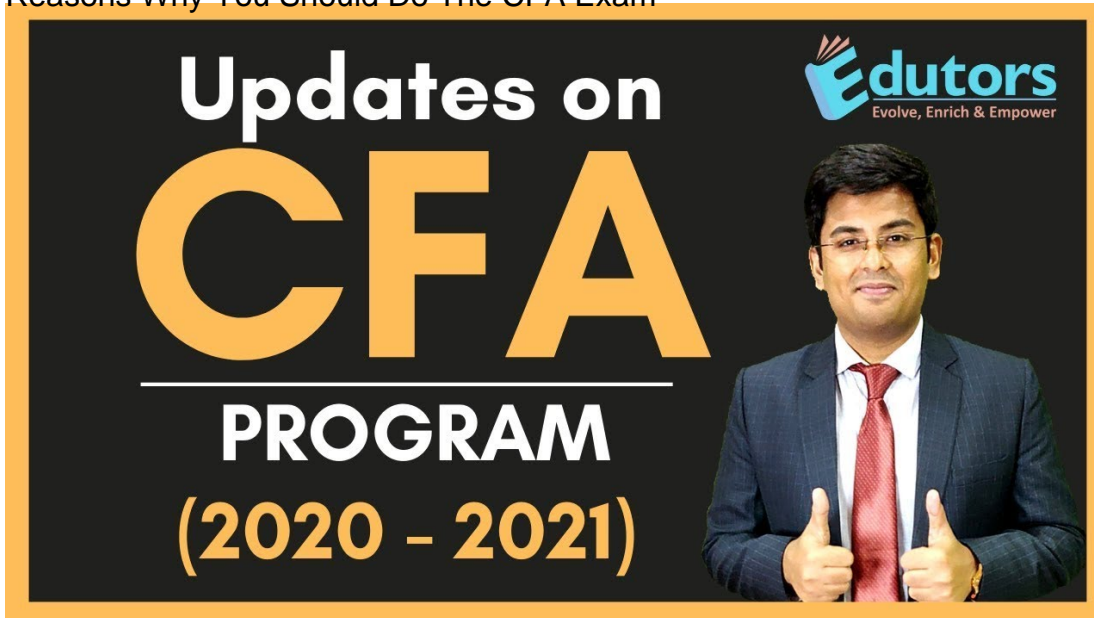


What You Need To Know About The CFA Exam

There is sentence completion with three unique choices and questions with three individual choices. You will need to understand all the features of your calculator as you will need to use it. Since there is no negative marking, it is wise to attempt all questions.
