Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



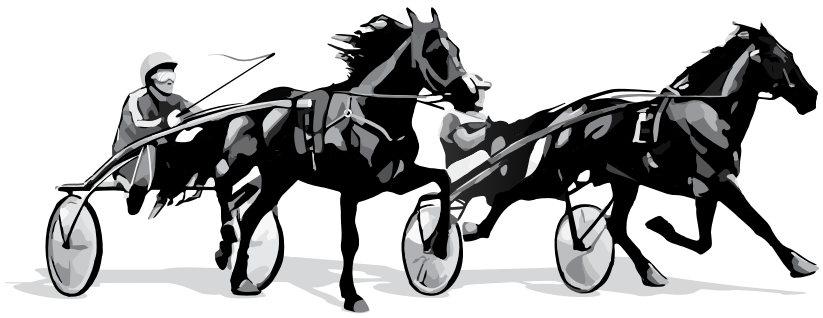
Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

#11 AMINI was a winner in her first start back since the shutdown on June 11th in NW2 and then picked up smaller shares against difficult foes in NW5 in back-to-back efforts. She was trapped along the pylons for much of her latest and overloaded with pace in deep stretch to charge forward to grab the place spot behind Postmodernism. This filly was a winner in two of these divisions last season and then was the third-place finisher in the OSS Grassroots Final. She should be brave off her latest but must overcome starting from the second-tier, as we have seen it cause havoc for many horses in the past but we will still give her the nod in the opener.

#4 CL SPORTSEXTREME won three divisions of the OSS Grassroots at two and has not had much of a chance in her first two starts as a sophomore in taking on top notch OSS Gold fillies in NW5. She now gets to take on competition tonight that should be much more to her liking but does not escape the one above, who she has been chasing in her last couple. This filly will have a much more favorable post but off recent form it is hard not to side with one above.

#8 JM SPORTSFAN was a lights out winner at Grand River Raceway in her latest when she brushed to the lead past the half and then devastated her competition by more than 12 lengths. She paced strongly through the wire in 1:53.4 and has now been no worse than second in all three of her starts as a sophomore. This filly began the season with back-to-back runner-up finishes that both came against Saulsbrook Olympia, who has now won six in a row including the final of the Kin Pace. She might enjoy the move to the bigger surface and can add some value to exotics.

#6 MIAMI SEELSTER was the easiest kind of winner in NW1 two weeks ago and then got a nightmarish journey last time in NW2. She was shuffled back to last around the final turn and had no chance of doing any better than her fourth-place finish under the line. This filly draws a better post this time and can get a piece of it with a more favorable trip.

#5 ISLAND BEACH BOY made multiple moves last week after leaving hard to the lead from the seven-hole and then marched back to the engine past the halfway point after two rivals looped around him down the backside. He paced open throttle for Filion to the three-quarter pole and tripped that marker in 1:21.3 with a third split in a blistering 26.3. You cannot blame this colt for getting leg weary late when he was picked up by a pair of foes on the wire by three quarters of a length to pace his own mile in 1:50.4. He has hit the board in six of nine lifetime and might break through this NW2 class this evening.

#2 TWIN B FIGHTER took on OSS Gold rivals last time in a race that was loaded with talent but was never in contention to finish seventh under the wire. He has only picked up a small cheque in four tries so far as a three-year-old and has turned in some underwhelming efforts. This gelding will now be making his second start back at Mohawk Park and had success for Hensley barn last season when he banked over \$114,000 and struck OSS gold once. He should appreciate the class relief but we need to see more out of him before we can put him on top.

#6 METALLICA was an impressive winner two back when he cruised to an easy victory at this level in 1:52.3. He ran into a difficult pair in his latest and had to settle for sixth but may have fared better if he did not encounter some traffic just before the wire. This colt faces a much easier group tonight and a forward placing would not be a surprise.

#7 TWIN B HEART THROB comes out of the same OSS Gold event as our second choice and finished alongside that rival under the wire. He was only beaten a neck at this level two starts back and was a winner in NW1 prior to that. A smaller share is expected.

He had not raced in over two weeks and had made a break in stride the start before at Yonkers. This colt now drops down to NW3 and gets back in on a regular rotation. He had a decent season at two and made the final of the William Wellwood Memorial here at Mohawk Park. Sylvain Filion will be back at the controls tonight and should be more familiar with this one now after driving him for the first time last week.

#5 RITSON shipped back to Mohawk Park for his latest and was an impressive winner in NW2 when he trotted past The Prince in the stretch to score in 1:55.4. He left out for the lead but was then relegated back to the three-hole down the backside before moving out again first-over. This colt was used multiple times in the mile and did well to come out on top. He has now won two in a row with the previous victory coming in the equivalent of the OSS Grassroots in Pennsylvania two starts back but now takes a leap upward in class. Using underneath.

#2 BELIEVER relocates north of the border to Mohawk Park and will make his first start out of the barn of Carmen Auciello. He has hit the board in five of 11 so far this season and his lone victory came at the Meadowlands back in April. This colt was a runner-up in the Pennsylvania Stallion Series two back and had hit the board in four straight prior to his last. We have seen this barn have success with these types in the past and this one cannot be dismissed.

#10 WARRAWEE WHISPER was a winner two starts back in NW2 and then followed it up with a decent runner-up finish to Logan Park at this level on June 25th. He is the stablemate of our second choice and can get a piece of this if he can get away well from the outermost post.

#8 GOOD NIGHT MOON looked like she might have seconditis after her first three starts of her sophomore season but then broke through with a victory in her latest when she scored by open lengths in 1:53.4. She will have a tougher assignment in this OSS Grassroots division but might be trending in the right direction to be up for the challenge. This filly did not have much of an excuse two starts back but it was her first time she was on the lead when entering the stretch. She looked a lot better in her latest when she was under-wraps a long way before the wire. James MacDonald had his choice of four in here and opted to stick with her and we will too.

#10 SHIATZU SEELSTER won two divisions of the OSS Grassroots as a rookie and earned a small cheque in the championship here last fall. She began her sophomore season south of the border and picked up a victory at Freehold on May 14th when she was placed up from second via disqualification. This filly did not have much success in two tries here back in June but found the winner's circle in her most recent effort at Georgian Downs in NW2500L3 on July 3rd. She has enough early foot to overcome the outside draw and merits consideration.

#7 SPORTS CHECK competed at the OSS Gold level last season and was the runner-up to Alumni Seelster at that more difficult level here last July. She was a winner in the first start of her career, but it took her over a year to notch her second victory, which came on June 26th in NW2 at Georgian Downs. This filly might enjoy returning to the big track and is worth a look. She loses Jamieson to the Menary pupil but picks up the services of Bob McClure.

#3 BET LIGHT did not have much of a chance in her last try over Mohawk Park when she got away ninth off the gate from post-seven in NW2. She came a back-half in 56.3 on that occasion and since spent two starts at Clinton Raceway after making the final of the Kin Pace. This filly might get overlooked but likely has a chance to hit the ticket.

Henry angled her to the outside, but she was caught behind a wall of horses before shaking loose to the outside and charging late to claim the show spot. She might get handled more aggressively this time around and rates highly in this spot.

#7 HALLSGLENSMAVIS was in a similar spot as the one above in the stretch but did not have the benefit of finding daylight because she was directly behind the leader that tired badly at the head of the stretch. She seemed loaded with pace for much of the stretch drive and had been the runner-up in her two tries at the level prior to that effort. This mare merits respect and might try to score on the engine in her third consecutive start from the seven-hole.

#4 TUGGINGONCREDIT was an easy winner in this class two starts back on June 28th when she got a perfect trip to score going away in 1:52.4. She then disappointed at 40 cents to the dollar last week when she was sent to the lead before the halfway point and then faded to sixth in the stretch. This mare was claimed out of that contest by trainer Amanda Fine, who has won four of her last 10 starts overall at the time of writing this. She has rebound potential.

She forged to the lead from the first-over position in the stretch and opened a wide margin before tiring late to finish fourth. This filly won two divisions of the OSS Grassroots last season before trying gold company but then took down the Grassroots Final at 14-1 last fall. She must start from the outermost post but has enough tactical speed to get spotted early by Drury. Giving her the edge in a competitive looking contest.

#5 SHES A SASSY BEACH did not have much of a chance in her latest at Georgian Downs when she tried to go forward off the gate from the eight-hole and was caught three-wide in the first turn before being wrestled back to second last on the outside. She never saw the pylons for duration of the mile and ended up third-over coming off the final turn. This filly might have finished third if she did not get sideways briefly in the stretch and now might enjoy the switch back to the bigger surface at Mohawk Park. She picks up Bob McClure and is worth a look.

#6 VOLUPTUOUS finished second to a pumped-up Miami Seelster in her first start at Mohawk Park on June 18th and then followed it up with an easy score in 1:52 flat the following week. That victory came in NW1, and she now must face rivals that have raced in more difficult spots leading into this Grassroots tilt. This daughter of Sunshine Beach might be able to handle the transition but will likely go off at a price that is shorter than we are willing to take.

#9 SPORTS DUCHESS has been the runner-up in back-to-back efforts at Clinton Raceway, including the Kin Pace Final in her latest. She got a slick steer from Jamieson who gave her a perfect two-hole trip and will now have to do more work from a difficult starting spot. She has enough tactical speed to get away for position off the switch and should not be counted out.

#1 GRANDMA HEIDI plunged back down to this level after taking on much tougher in the top condition class for trotters last week. She got a two-hole trip in that contest and got past the leader up the cones in the stretch before tiring to finish fifth. This mare now drops back down to the level she was the runner-up in on June 26th when Muscle Fashion got past her in the stretch for the upset. That rival went on to finish second at 62-1 last week in the same event that Heidi comes out of. She does not face the toughest group this time around but might have a hard time making the lead off the gate from the pole position with new slanted gate at Mohawk Park. Either way though, she is hard to look past at this level.

#2 I GOT THE LOOKS finished second in a dead heat at this level last week when he came from a long way out of it. He got away eighth off the gate from the eight-hole and was still nine lengths off the lead at the halfway point. He trotted his back-half in 56 seconds flat with a final quarter in 27.4. The winner Run Director was much too tough but this one produced a rock-solid effort in defeat. Christoforou opts to drive the one below and Trevor Henry gets the call.

#5 ONLY FOR JUSTICE looked like he was cruising to victory last week when HP Bruxelles repelled his challenge in the stretch. He briefly got his neck in front but then could not get past that rival again until after the wire. This winner of more than \$360,000 is making his third start back at Mohawk Park and while he moves back up a notch in class, he is typically dangerous in the middle condition ranks.

We are fond of this filly and think she will extend her win-streak to lucky number seven. The pick.

#9 A BETTER GAME was an impressive winner here at Mohawk Park on June 15th when returning from south of the border and making her first start back in over a month. She then turned in an eye-catching effort to win her elimination of the Kin Pace at Clinton two starts back but then had to rough it first-over in the final. This filly ended up finishing fourth in that added money event and was unable hold off the late charge of the one above, who had the benefit of following her throughout. She should appreciate the move back to the big track and has rebound potential.

#4 WESTERN WISH was a winner here at Mohawk Park on June 17th in NW2 in her first start out of the barn of Carmen Auciello. She was a going away winner under the wire in 1:52 flat but was then scratched out of her next scheduled start due to sickness. This filly has now missed almost a month of action but merits consideration.

#7 GAME OF SHADOWS finished third in NW3 in her return to Mohawk Park on July 2nd. It was her first start back on Canadian soil after a six-race stint south of the border during the shutdown. She was stakes placed here last season and will be in the mix with a favorable trip.

#8 NORTHERN LUXURY broke her maiden at Georgian Downs in her latest after making a break in stride here on June 24th. She picks up the services of Bob McClure and might be able to outrun her odds.

- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
