A poor internet connection is the most frequent reason for Minecraft failure in your Windows PC. Do check your internet connection, fix it if not working, and then try launching Minecraft again. Corrupt launcher files - If the launcher files on your computer are corrupted, the game won't start. You will need to delete the launcher files in order to launch the game once more. You can find the launcher files ".minecraft" folder. Drivers issue This is another common issue. This is a very common problem. Check if you have installed any recent updates in your operating system and if it is an optional one you can remove it and then try to launch the game again. The system is not up-to-date Each game or program has some specific system requirements Check if your system is compatible or not. Let's look at some possible solutions to the issue. 1. Check Haters gonna hate connection 2. Remove corrupt launcher files Update the graphic card driver 4. Run Minecraft as administrator 5. Remove Minecraft mods 6. Re-install Minecraft 1] Check your internet connection

Poor connectivity is a common reason why a game does not start. It is possible that your internet connection is not optimized for gaming, and consequently your Minecraft game is not launching. Change your internet connection to start the game again. 2] Delete corrupt launcher files

The launcher files may become corrupted and the game may not start. The only fix to this issue is to delete the launcher files from the "Minecraft" folder on your PC, but then you have to install all your profiles manually. To find the Minecraft launcher files-- Open the Run dialog box by pressing Win+R- Type %appdata%- Go to the ".minecraft" folder- Locate the file called "launcher_profiles.json" and delete it.- Launch Minecraft and make new profiles from Settings. 3. Update the graphics card driver

If you are running an old version of the graphics card driver installed on your computer, Minecraft will not launch. To fix or update the problem with the graphics driver you can download any driver upgrader that is free. This can help Minecraft launch smoothly. If needed update the driver and start the game again. You can also check for optional driver updates.4] Run Minecraft administrator

Privilege issues can be the reason why your game isn't running. This issue can be fixed by running Minecraft as an administrator. To do that, go to Minecraft, right-click and run it as an administrator. This should solve your issue.

Games are usually constantly adding all available mods (modifications). These are user-created modifications and are intended to enhance the gameplay but sometimes they may cause problems when the launch of your game. Remove all the Minecraft Mods before launching the game.6] Re-install Minecraft

If none of the above fixes worked for you, it is best to uninstall the game and install it again. To remove Microsoft Press Win+R and enter "%appdata" Minecraft folder and right-click. Choose delete.
