

# GitHub IdreesInc/Monocraft: A Programming Font Based on the Typeface used In Minecraft

The font for developers who love Minecraft a bit too much.

Note This project isn't connected to Minecraft or Mojang in any way, and is solely a fan project. This font is a copy of the Minecraft UI font, but it doesn't come with any font files or assets.

- Minecraft! - This font was inspired by the Minecraft UI typeface. A few glyphs were changed to improve the readability and spacing.

LAUNCHER

- Each character has been created to work in monospaced fonts. Thin characters like "i" or "l" have been reworked using tasteful serifs, tails and other details that look better in monospaced environments.

All new ligature characters are accessible to spice up your programming experience. Arrows appear to be arrows now, and comparison operators are simpler to spot at an eye

## How to install

Download the latest Monocraft.otf file from the page for releases. Right-click on the downloaded font and choose Install. Based on the type of computer you use you may require administrative access to install fonts.

## Mac

Download the most recent Monocraft.otf file from the Releases page. Double-click on the downloaded font file and select Install Font in the window that appears. More help is available [here](#).

Follow the steps above to install the font. Then, choose the Monocraft font (note the space) from any application that supports custom fonts. You might need to restart the application or your computer in order for the font to be displayed.
