World Of Warcraft 3.3.5a Client Download

After playing on this server and becoming hooked, I started using Wine on my Macbook to play while I was out and near a Wifi network.

After having had enough of the problems wine causes when running WoW.exe, I found a simple and effective way to run it natively on Mac. I'm using Mac OS 10.10.2 and WoW is running at 120+ Fps.

- 1. Download the Dalaran-WoW 3.3.5a Client for Windows.
- 2. Download the World of Warcraft 3.3.5a .app file from here: http://www.mediafire.com/download/3i9hsjmp4ygwgxu/World of Warcraft.zip
- 3. Extract the .zip file and move the World of Warcraft.app file into the World of Warcraft folder alongside wow.exe

Double-clicking the World of Warcraft.app will launch the game. However, there is one tweak that can be made to improve performance. This guide is compatible with Linux.

The following settings on Linux and Mac will result in a noticeable performance improvement. WoW will be rendered using OpenGL, which can be found natively on Linux and Mac.

I can confirm that Linux 64-Bit (Running Arch 64bit), with wine 1.7.3, OpenGL settings, and performance is up to 10-20 FPS.

- 1. Navigate to your WTF folder and open config.wtf with TextEdit or a similar program (Do not use Microsoft Office).
- 2. Scroll to the bottom and add the following: SETgxApi OpenGL
- 3. Save the file and close.

That's it! Although I don't have 10.10.2, this should work for Lion, Mountain Lion, and Mavericks.
