ITINERARY

THURSDAY

Thursday Morning



Arrival to **PRAGUE**, the beautiful capital of Bohemia and the Czech Republic. After being greeted at the airport and escorted to the **KING DAVID HOTEL**, enjoy a welcome buffet and meet up with the group.

Thursday Afternoon



We begin our tour of MYSTICAL PRAGUE with three of the remaining shuls dating back to Medieval Times. See the architecture and decor of the restored buildings, as well as the rich collection of Judaica items on exhibit. Next we will move on to the ANCIENT CEMETERY and adjacent Chevra Kadisha building. View original artwork and artifacts depicting the life cycle and burial customs of Kehilas Prague. We will spend private time beside the Kever of the MAHARAL and KLEI YAKAR, and have a

chance to daven and leave a Kvittel.

Thursday Evening



We will conclude our tour of JEWISH OLD TOWN PRAGUE with a private viewing of the historic ALTNEU (Old New) Shul. The chair of the Maharal is on display, as well as several acrostics painted on the walls, referencing key verses of Jewish faith and hope, replicated from the Maharal's time.

After Maariv in the Altneu Shul, we'll visit the 'new' cemetery, where the NODA BYEHUDA is buried. Now only a small part of the original cemetery remains, the rest destroyed to make way for a television tower during Soviet occupation. Although the Matzeva's four sides look homogeneous, they took over 100 years to complete.

Return to the hotel for a BANQUET DINNER

accompanied by live musical entertainment. Meet

with some locals, and hear from the Rosh Hayeshiva and other guests.

FRIDAY

Friday Morning

After Shachris and breakfast we depart for THERESIENSTADT. The first concentration camp of its kind, preceeding Auschwitz by 3 years. Visit the hidden shul, mass graves and crematorium spread through the compound. Originally built as a fortress in the 16th century and then used as barracks for Czech soldiers, the fortress was built to accommodate 7,000 soldiers. At its peak in 1944 there were over 75,000 Jewish prisoners held in Theresienstadt. We will end our tour with a visit to the museum and learn how the Germans used this concentration camp to decieve the world, portraying the camp as a



quaint village where the Jews had cafés, operas and freedom and luxury bestowed by the benevolent third Reich.

Friday Afternoon

Upon our return to Prague indulge in some great shopping, take a walk around the **OLD TOWN SQUARE** or relax in the hotel. Enjoy a full fleishig Toameha, and get ready for Shabbos.

SHABBOS

Friday Evening

After licht bentching we will walk around the corner to the Jerusalem Synagogue, also known as the JUBILEE SYNAGOGUE. Built in 1906 in Morrish Revival style, it is one of the nicest shuls in Central Europe. This is the perfect location for kabalas shabbos. Be treated to a davening by our GUEST CHAZAN and a drasha by the Rosh Hayeshiva before returning to the hotel for Seudas Leil Shabbos. After a delicious Heimish Seuda we will have an Oneg Shabbos and Kumzitz lasting late into the night. A walking tour will be available after the Oneg.

Sunday Morning


Today we depart Bohemian Prague for MORAVIA, HOLESOV, **BRATISLAVA AND VIENNA.** Depart on board a private train with

After the banquet we will travel to the hotel in a procession of HORSE DRAWN CARRIAGES. Travel up the Ringstratsse and view the magnificent historical landmarks lining the circular grand boulevard. Pass by the Hofburg Palace, Vienna State Opera and House of Parliament all brilliantly lit up. Arrive to our HOTEL **KEMPINSKI PALAIS HANSEN** and admire the dual entrances built to accommodate the grand carriages arriving when the building was used as a Palace as originally built in 1906.
