Introduction: Palm Sunday choir from my childhood What is the message we hear on Palm Sunday?

- A lot of noise
- From someone out of sight
- Who makes us uncomfortable

What is the message Jesus wants us to hear?

Who He is and what He is doing

- I. Who is this (noisemaker)?
 - a. A prophet
 - i. He makes a prophecy (v2-3)
 - ii. He fulfills prophecy (v4-5)
 - b. A Priest
 - i. He purifies worship (v12)
 - ii. He protects prayer (v13a)
 - iii. He extends grace (v13b)
 - iv. He provides sacrifice (v12 -> cross)
 - c. A King: Claims made by Jesus (v3), Crowd (v9), Prophecy (v5) Proofs:
 - i. Fulfills royal prophecy (v5)
 - ii. Claims royal ride (v2)
 - iii. Receives royal praise
 - 1. Victory carpet (v8)
 - 2. Victory chant (v9)
 - 3. Victory lap (the journey he's made)
- II. What He did
 - a. He was a prophet who rode into the jaws of his prophecy
 - b. He was a priest who offered the perfect sacrifice to satisfy divine justice + reconcile us
 - c. He was the King of glory who set it aside to give us his glory

Conclusion: Though he deserved the glory of heaven, he descended to the agonies of hell to claim peace for our souls
