On June 12, 2015 Captain Minard and myself met with City of Poughkeepsie School Superintendent Nicole Williams in the Detective Bureau conference room. Williams was there to notify us that she had received an e mail from a [redacted] in which [redacted] stated that she had been engaged on several occasions as a prostitute by an Assistant Superintendent for Finance STANLEY BRONSKI. That on one occasion she had waited for BRONSKI at his hotel room at the [redacted]. When BRONSKI didn't show up she called him and he told her to come to the District Offices. When [redacted] arrived BRONSKI met her at the front door and asked her to come in and "service" him. [redacted] refused and BRONSKI refused to pay her. [redacted] then wrote the e mail to Superintendent WILLIAMS because she said BRONSKI owes her \$800 for her time and she wanted the District to know what BRONSKI was doing. Included in the e mail was a phone for [redacted].

On June 16, 2015 I called [redacted] and spoke with her by phone. [redacted] said she is no longer doing "that stuff" any more. She didn't want anything from the District, she just wanted the District to know what BRONSKI was doing.

On June 24, 2015 BRONSKI resigned from the School District and there was a settlement agreement between BRONSKI and the DISTRICT.

This case is closed as there was no criminal activity that occurred in the City of Poughkeepsie. Any exchange of money for sex took place outside the City of Poughkeepsie.
