Boston Free Speech Anniversary March against Far-Left Violence

"In the heat of summer on August 19th 2017, a group of over 40 Americans gathered on The Boston Common. What was simply a rally dedicated to the defense, and celebration of the US Constitution was falsely labeled a racist/neo-nazi rally by the mainstream media. "

Determined to show the country, those 45,000 hateful people and Boston Mayor Martin Walsh that we would not be deterred; Boston Free Speech has been active in the area countering anti free speech groups, and holding rallies of their own alongside other groups in the area.
