Cruise ships sail into the heart of Antigua's capital, Saint John's, docking at Heritage Quay and Redcliffe Quay.



Inhabited by Arawaks when British settlers arrived in the 17th century, Anguilla was part of the self-governing colony of St. Kitts-Nevis-Anguilla until 1967, when it seceded unilaterally.

A bid for full independence led to the landing of British troops in 1969. Anguilla became a separate British dependency in 1980. Anguilla is the most northerly of the Leeward Islands in the Eastern Caribbean. It is a flat island with an area of some 91 sq. km but limited natural resources.


It has, however, one of the most important largely unbroken coral reefs in the Eastern Caribbean. Its coastal and marine biodiversity (including fish, seabirds and marine turtles) is the island's most important natural asset. Aruba has three deep water harbors located at Oranjestad, Barcadera, and San Nicolaas. The coastal area is known for its white-sand beaches and the calm waters surrounding Aruba are clear, making it a popular tourist destination.




Aruba's Town Hall, Aruban styled mansion was erected between 1922 and 1925.

A number of daily nonstop flights arrive from New York, Miami, Toronto and Montreal at the international airport in Christ Church Parish, 11 miles east of Bridgetown. Charters from the east coast also bring visitors to the island. Connections from some American cities can best be made through San Juan, Puerto Rico. This island is also a very important hub with numerous flights to and from nearby islands. Flights from Europe (primarily the United Kingdom and Germany) are frequent.


During the high season, charters from Atlanta, North Carolina, New York and Miami operate directly into the island of St. Kitts. Connecting flights are also available from San Juan or other Caribbean islands. Arrivals on Nevis comes either on the eightminute flight from St. Kitts or via the ferry between Basseterre, St. Kitts and Charlestown, Nevis, (a 45-minute trip). Boat facilities for private vehicles to be transported across to Nevis are also available.

As a cruise destination, St. Kitts and Nevis have grown quickly in the past few years. Major cruise lines berth in the capital of St. Kitts whilst only small charters venture to Nevis.





Its two peaks that rise over 2,000 feet above sea, have impressed all who see them, from today's tourists to the sailors of the past five centuries. Interior mountains are covered by forest, surrounded by banana plantations, and ringed by coastal fishing villages that have changed little from a century ago.

St. Lucia's charm does not stop at its foliage and twin peaks, its northern end has some of the most beautiful golden sand beaches with a fantastic nightlife to compliment it. Black shiny sand beaches can also be found on the southern end of this island.

There are two airports on the island that accommodated regular flights to the island. Most non stop flights are normally facilitated at the Hewanorra Airport which is to the South of the island. Meanwhile, connecting flights normally come through the George F.L Charles Airport. Make sure your agent selects the airport which is closet to your accommodations if you don't wish to travel an additional 1hr 30mins by taxi. Most ships call at Castries, from there shoppers can walk to the nearby Pointe Seraphine or a ferry ride to La Palace Carenage. Site seers can reach the city with in 15 mins from their ship. Some ships occasionally make a special stop to the south of the island so that clients can have a sight of the famous twin peaks.



Wedding ceremonies are legally conducted on the Dutch side only as the French side requires a 1 month stay before legal ceremonies can be done.

Nonstop Jets from U.S and European cities are frequent. The island has airports on both the French and Dutch side but all international flights even those from France arrive on the Dutch side.

As a port St. Maarten is surpassed in numbers only by some islands. This is due to its high level of development, excellent shopping and fantastic, easily accessible beaches. The 2 major ports offer excellent shopping and is only walking distance.
