Background Context

REVIVE – reduce explosive violence, increase victim empowerment

A coalition of charities and the private sector to raise awareness of the impact caused to civilians by explosive violence

In 2018, the All-Party Parliamentary Group on Explosive Threats undertook an inquiry to examine the extent of harm caused by explosive violence internationally. The inquiry culminated in a report published in Parliament and presented to Ministers in June. Tangible results from this inquiry are already showing.

REVIVE was created to support that inquiry as an awareness and media campaign focusing on the individuals and organisations providing help and support to victims of explosive violence.

REVIVE targets media and parliamentarians to deliver raised awareness of the impact of being caught up in an explosive incident and the aftermath.

The partner charities so far are: Action on Armed Violence; Emergency UK; Find a Better Way; International Refugee Trust and Legacy of War Foundation.






