Modding can be quite difficult in certain games however, Minecraft Forge makes it all fairly simple. Once you've installed the Minecraft Forge client, you'll be able to select it as a profile in your Minecraft launcher, and then you can add the option to look up a list of your mods.

You can then select the mods you want to use, and launch the game as usual. You can also open the mods folder in case you have just downloaded mods. Click the button near the bottom of the list to do this. This allows you to transfer the mod you downloaded into the mods directory without needing to manually look for it.

First, go to Minecraftforge (opens in a new tab) and download the program. Make sure that you download the Forge version that corresponds with the Minecraft version you're using. If Minecraft is 1.1 then you must download the 1.1 version.

- Go to the downloaded file (it should be at

'C:\Users\\[username]\AppData\Roaming\\.minecraft\mods') and open. Note: If you can't run the installer, check whether you have Java (opens in new tab) installed.

Select the option to install the Client Then click 'OK'.

- Open Minecraft and change the profile to 'forge'.

Once the game is loaded it will show a Mods menu that's new on the screen that starts.

Click this to choose the options you'd like to have.

If you're looking for a few modifications to test out with Minecraft Forge that'll help streamline the experience of playing This is a good starting point:

JustEnoughltems (opens new tab) - This mod for viewing recipes and items is one of our most downloaded mods and simplifies the process of browsing and using materials.

JourneyMap (opens in a new tab) - This mod creates an interactive map of your world as you explore and marks places of interest. It can be viewed in game or even in the web browser.

MouseTweaks (opens in a new tab) Moving and clicking can be an issue and Mouse Tweaks optimizes it by introducing two different left mouse clicks and making use of the mouse wheel, which means you can speed the process up.
