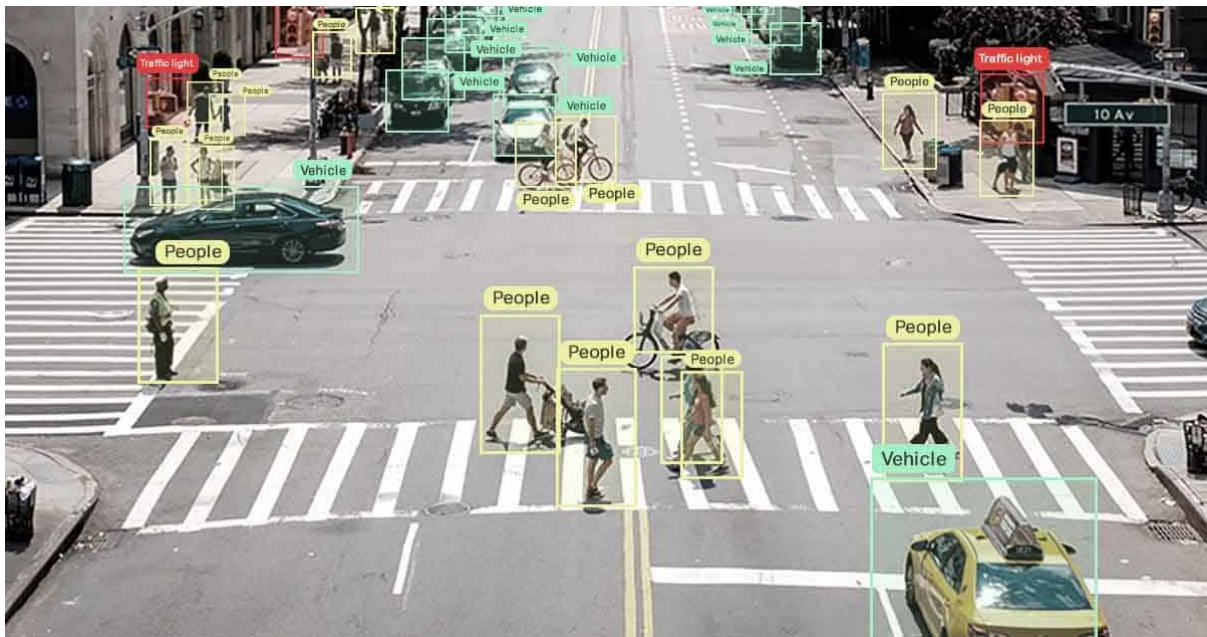


Popular Trends in Image Annotation
