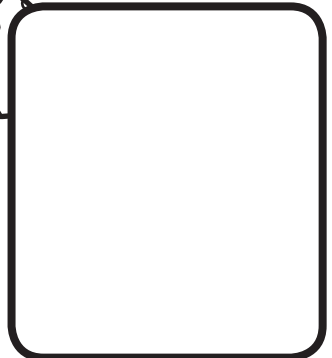
Bourneville Bunny 1910s

Wilfred 1920s

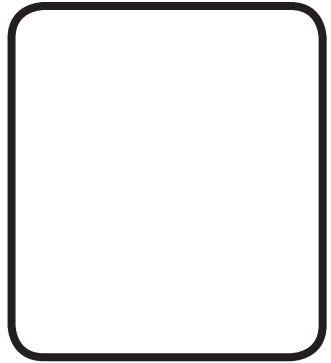
Walk down through wartime Britain, past the peace mugs towards Pip, Squeak and Wilfred in the 1920s. Draw Wilfred the rabbit in the box.





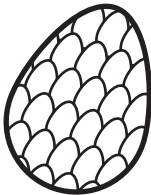
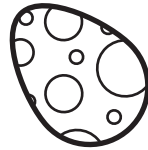
Guinness Rabbit 1950s

Walk through the Second World War and find the Festival of Britain in the 1950s. A Guinness poster is getting curious-er and curious-er. Draw this costumed hare in the box.



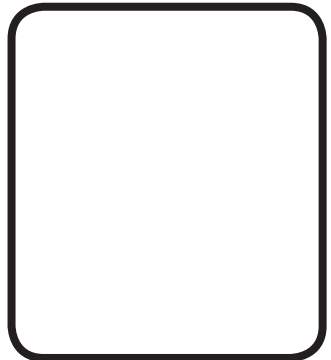
Disney's Thumper 1950s

Walk down through wartime Britain, past the peace mugs towards Pip, Squeak and Wilfred in the 1920s. Draw Wilfred the rabbit in the box.



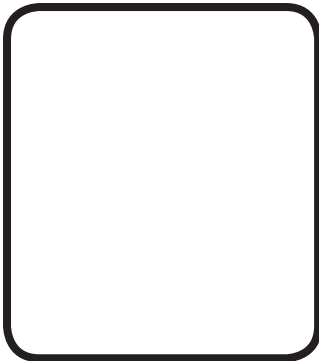
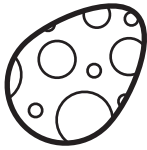


Duracell Bunny 1970s

What is your favourite instrument?

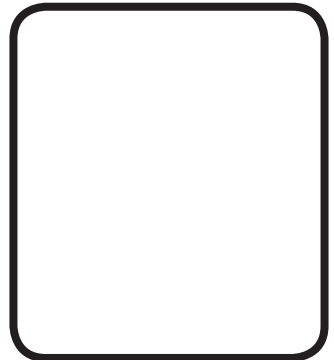
What is the name of the bunny standing beside him?



Chris Rabbit 1980s

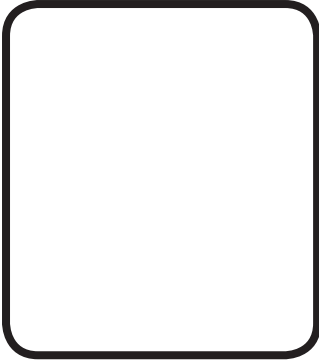
Keep searching and you will find Henry's Cat. This yellow cat has a rabbit friend, if you can spot him draw him in the box to the right.

Look up and you will find a Roger Rabbit Wacky Head. Draw him in the box, and try out his sneaky walk into the 1990s.



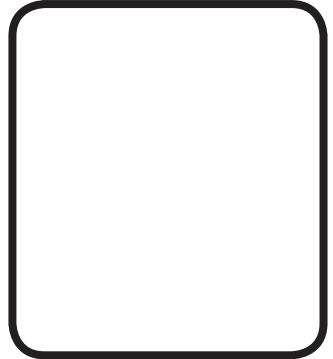
Nesquik Rabbit 1990s
