

Tension

It is important to check your tension before starting your garment. If there are too many stitches to 10 cm, your tension is tight and you should change to a larger size needle. If there are too few, your tension is loose and you should change to a smaller size needle.


Caution

It is essential to work to the stated tension, and we cannot accept responsibility for the finished product if any yarn other than the specified yarn is used.

Abbreviations

K=knit; P=purl; st=stitch; stocking st=1 row K, 1 row P; garter st=every row K; tog=together; tbl=through back of loops; inc=increase by working into front and back of st; dec=decrease by working 2 sts together; beq=beginning; alt=alternate; rep=repeat; cont= continue; meas=measures; foll= following; rem=remain(ing); RS=right side; **WS**=wrong side; cm= centimetres; in=inches; mm= millimetres; sL1K=slip 1 knitways; yfwd=yarn forward; psso=pass slip st over; patt=pattern; 0=no st, row or time to be worked in this size: M1=make a st by picking up horizontal loop lying before next st and working into back of it.

K1bw=K1 below, K into next st 1 row below, at the same time slipping off st above (see diagram).



MB=make bobble as follows: (K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1) in next st, then pass 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th sts on right needle separately over first st.

Tw2R=K into front of second st on left needle, then K into front of first st and slip both sts off needle together.

Tw2L=K into back of second st on left needle, then K into front of first st and slip both sts off needle together.

Cr2FP=slip next st on cable pin and leave at front of work, P1, then K1 from cable pin.

Cr2BP=slip next st on cable pin and leave at back of work, K1, then P1 from cable pin.

Cr3FP=slip next st on cable pin and leave at front of work, P2, then K1 from cable pin.

Cr3BP=slip next 2 sts on cable pin and leave at back of work, K1, then P2 from cable pin.

U.S.A. Glossary

Cast off=bind off; tension=gauge; knit up=pick up and knit; stocking st=stockinette st; yarn forward, yarn over needle or yarn round needle=yarn over.

Instructions are given for the first size, with larger size(s) given in square brackets []. Where only one figure is given this applies to both (all) sizes.

Before starting to knit, read the instructions carefully and circle all figures relating to your size with a coloured pencil.

Drying Instructions

Do not dry handknits in harsh sunlight as fading or yellowing may occur.

You may tumble dry your garment with confidence in any domestic tumble dryer at temperatures of up to 60°C. Recommended by Hoover.

Circular Shawl (illustrated in Shade 3300) **Measurement** Diameter, when blocked, approx 158 cm 62 Quantity Patons Fairytale 3 ply 50 gram balls Quantities of yarn are approximate as they are based on average requirements. Check actual yarn colour - as printing may not match yarn exactly. Pair Patons 4 1/2 mm (UK 7/USA 7) needles. Next row - K. Tension Rep last 2 rows once more (6 sts). 22 1/2 sts to 10 cm in width over centre patt (from ** to **) on 4 1/2 mm needles or size needed to Next row - (K2tog) 3 times. Cast off. achieve stated tension. **BORDER** For notes and abbreviations, see first page of text. Cast on 40 sts. **CENTRE (Make 4 pieces)** Row 1 - (RS), K3, yfwd, K2tog, K1, yfwd, (K1, P1) into next st, yon, K2, K2tog, P1, K2tog, K3, yfwd, Cast on 168 sts. K2tog, yfwd, K2, P1, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd,K3, yfwd, K4, (yfwd, K2tog) twice, yfwd, K2 (44 sts). **Row 1 - (RS), K2, *yfwd, sL1K, K2, psso; rep from * to last st, K1. Row 2 - K1, P19, (K1, P9) twice, K4.

Row 3 - K1, *sL1K, K2, psso, yfwd; rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 4 - P.

Row 2 - P.

Rows 5 to 8 - As rows 1 to 4. Rows 9 to 11 - As rows 1 to 3.

Row 12 - K.**

Row 13 - K18, (sL1K, K2tog, psso, K40) 3 times, sL1K, K2tog, psso, K18 (160 sts).

Row 14 - K.

Row 15 - K17, (sL1K, K2tog, psso, K38) 3 times,

sL1K, K2tog, psso, K17 (152 sts).

Row 16 - K.

Row 17 - K16, (sL1K, K2tog, psso, K36) 3 times,

Row 18 - K.

Last 18 rows form patt (noting dec). Rep from ** to ** once more.

sL1K, K2tog, psso, K16 (144 sts).

Next row - K15, (sL1K, K2tog, psso, K34) 3 times,

sL1K, K2tog, psso, K15 (136 sts). Cont in patt, dec as before (working one st less at each end of row, and two sts less between each

dec) in alt garter st rows until 24 sts rem. Next row - K.

Rep from ** to ** once more.

Next row - *K2tog; rep from * to end (12 sts).

Row 3 - K3, yfwd, K2tog, K1, yfwd, (K1, P1) into

each of next 3 sts, yon, K2, K2tog, P1, K2tog, K3, (yfwd, K2tog) twice, P1, K2tog, yfwd, K2tog, (yfwd, K5) twice, (yfwd, K2tog) twice, yfwd, K2 (49 sts).

Row 5 - K3, yfwd, (K2tog) twice, yfwd, K6, yfwd, K2, K2tog, P1, K2tog, K3, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, sL1K, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K7, yfwd, K6, yfwd,

Row 4 - K1, P21, K1, P8, K1, P13, K4.

(K2tog, yfwd) twice, K2 (50 sts). Row 6 - K1, P31, K1, P13, K4.

Row 7 - K3, yfwd, (K2tog) twice, yfwd, K6, yfwd,

K2, K2tog, P1, K2tog, K3, yfwd, sL1K, K1, psso, sL1K, K2tog, psso, then pass the first of these 2 sts

over the last st, yfwd, K4, P1, K4, yfwd, K4, K2tog, yfwd, K1, (yfwd, K2tog) twice, yfwd, K2 (49 sts).

Row 8 - K1, P18, K1, P11, K1, P13, K4, Row 9 - K3, yfwd, (K2tog) twice, yfwd, K6, yfwd, K2, K2tog, P1, K2tog, K2, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K3,

K2tog, P1, K2tog, K3, yfwd, K3, K2tog, yfwd, K3, (yfwd, K2tog) twice, yfwd, K2 (49 sts). Row 10 - K1, P19, K1, P10, K1, P4, (K1, P1) into

each of next 6 sts, P3, K4 (55 sts). Row 11 - K3, yfwd, (K2tog) twice, yrn, P12, yon,

K2, K2tog, P1, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K3,

K2tog, P1, K2tog, K3, yfwd, K4, yfwd, sL1K, K1,

psso, K3, (yfwd, K2tog) twice, yfwd, K2 (55 sts). Row 12 - K1, P20, K1, P9, K1, P4, (K2tog) 6 times.

P3, K4 (49 sts).

Row 13 - K3, yfwd, (K2tog) twice, yrn, P6, yon, K2, K2tog, P1, K2, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K3, K2tog, P1,

K2tog, (yfwd, K2tog) 3 times, K1 (48 sts).

K2tog, K3, yfwd, K4, yfwd, sL1K, K1, psso, K1, leave to dry.

Using a flat seam, join 4 centre pieces together.

MAKE UP

Do not press.

Join Border to form a circle and attach straight edge

to outside edge of centre, easing in fullness. Pin out shawl to form a circle, cover with a damp cloth and

with row 30. Cast off.

Row 14 - K1, P19, K1, P9, K1, P4, (K2tog) 3 times,

Row 15 - K3, yfwd, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K1, yrn, P3tog, yon, K2, K2tog, P1, K2, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K3,

K2tog, P1, K2tog, K2, yfwd, (K1, P1) into next st, yon, K5, yfwd, sL1K, K2tog, psso, (yfwd, K2tog) 3

Row 17 - K3, yfwd, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K3, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K1, K2tog, P1, K2, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd,

K3, K2tog, P1, K2tog, K2, yfwd, (K1, P1) into each

of next 3 sts, yon, K7, K2tog, (yfwd, K2tog) twice,

Row 19 - K3, yfwd, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K5, (yfwd,

K2tog) twice, P1, (K2tog, yfwd) twice, K3, K2tog, P1, K2tog, K2, yfwd, K6, yfwd, K2tog, K3, K2tog,

Row 21 - K3, yfwd, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K7, yfwd,

K2tog, yfwd, sL1K, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd,

K3, K2tog, P1, K2tog, K2, yfwd, K6, yfwd, K2tog, K2, K2tog, (yfwd, K2tog) 3 times, K1 (48 sts).

Row 23 - K3, yfwd, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K4, P1, K4,

yfwd, sL1K, K1, psso, sL1K, K2tog, psso, then pass

the first of these 2 sts over the last st. vfwd. K3. K2tog, P1, K2tog, K2, yfwd, K6, yfwd, K2tog, K3,

Row 24 - K1, P11, (K1, P1) into each of next 6 sts.

Row 25 - K3, yfwd, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K3, K2tog, P1, K2tog, K3, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K2, K2tog, P1, K2tog,

K2, yrn, P12, yon, K2tog, K3, (yfwd, K2tog) 3 times,

Row 26 - K1, P11, (K2tog) 6 times, P4, K1, P10,

Row 27 - K3, yfwd, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K3, K2tog, P1,

K2tog, K3, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K1, K2tog, P1, K2tog,

K2, yrn, P6, yon, K2tog, K1, K2tog, (yfwd, K2tog) 3

Row 28 - K1, P10, (K2tog) 3 times, P4, K1, P9, K1,

Row 29 - K3, yfwd, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K3, K2tog, P1,

K2tog, K3, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K2, P1, K2tog, K2,

yrn, P3tog, yon, K1, yfwd, K3, (yfwd, K2tog) 3 times,

Cont in patt until work meas approx 377 cm, ending

Row 16 - K1, P20, K1, P9, K1, P10, K4.

Row 18 - K1, P23, K1, P9, K1, P11, K4.
