Programs

Elementary Program

TCDSB elementary students from junior kindergarten (age 4) to grade 8 (age 13) must be baptised Catholic with proof of the baptism. If not, their legal guardian must be baptised and reside in the city of Toronto.

Secondary Program

Catholic and non-Catholic international students can now apply to secondary schools within the Toronto Catholic District School Board (TCDSB).

The Toronto Catholic District School Board does not provide boarding facilities within its secondary schools.

Terms

We offer a Full-Time (September—June), Summer School and Short-term programs for students who are interested in studying through our program.



Tuition Fees

Full Year Tuition Fees for 2018-2019:

Elementary Program: \$13,000/yr Secondary Program: \$14,500/yr

An application fee of \$200 CAD is required when submitting your application. All fees must be paid in Canadian funds.

Activity and consumable fees are charged by the school location at the beginning of the school year.

Additional fees for school excursion and trips may apply.



Medical Insurance

A comprehensive medical insurance plan is mandatory and is included in the cost of the tuition fee.
