Introduction & Book Proposal

People love the idea of Medieval legends. The imagination retreats from the ordinary by reading books on eternal romance, blood feuds for power, angel lore, and Royalty living in stone castles in France, Scotland, or England. The stories of Charlemagne have popular appeal that spans cultures and time. He lived something magical, in fact, he was a Holy Roman Emperor, he became the King of the Franks, he did things superbly. It is in this story of a conqueror that readers engage the supernatural, and dream of attaining similar, almost fictional heights. Stories of such a Secret Reclamation then make the butterflies flutter in our bellies for they stir us to imagine the lofty longings

we may aspire to and achieve. He did create a nation of lovers and spoke romance languages from his lips. He practiced spirituality religiously, in fact, he seemed to have a special relationship with God Himself.

And so, we were compelled to join the Secret Society of Jacobites and pen a story that lends more graces to the lore that comes with the anticipation of the return of the King.

Our book shows how this Scion truly does exist in France. In fact, Carolingian Descendants scatter themselves throughout France, Scotland, England, Austria, Brazil, Monaco, and the world. This Epic story starts out as if fictional and takes on a life of its own turning what seems to be make-believe into reality in modern times. The Carolingian world is part magical and esoteric. Roman Catholic Prophecies abound about the White Lily Throne that conquered the Roman Empire. Its history comes replete with the tales of Saints and Angels working miracles through time making this account of true and accurate history telling seem like Hollywood.

The Scene opens on a tall and stalwart French man. He is overlooking a vast new stretch of land from a mountain side. Then, we flashback to his childhood. Pippin is his father. Charlemagne is his

boy. A few scenes show his good and excellent moral character, he is raised to be devout, he learns about Jesus, hears ministers preaching about Christ and picks up lessons of love, envisions greatness. He learns warfare in a relatively barbaric time, and he picks up a newer language in French and speaks several languages all according to lore.

Then we join Charlemagne when he is older, and very much ahead of his times. Chivalrous. Strong. Charming and Charismatic. Excellent manners. He starts a new country, a world of love, as exemplified by Jesus Christ of Nazareth. He teaches mannerisms and etiquette to his followers, his people, the Franks. He teaches then men to be kind to the women. In fact, in one scene, Charlemagne is shown teaching etiquette to his friends, reaching his hand outward toward his wife in greeting and kissing her hand as he draws near to

her, as the French are well known to have done in times past.

He encourages the fair treatment of slaves according to the teachings of Christianity. Catholicism becomes very important to him. He engages in intense and very involved interactions with priests. He starts fighting others like the Anglicans and Saxons, and claims France. He plunders those whom he conquers mercilessly though. He becomes wealthy by claiming conquered lands. He starts the feudal society. The Franks pay taxes to him. Charlemagne goes on his Crusades to Jerusalem. He fights the infidels, and conquers everywhere he goes. He sees visions of God, which are fires in his mind. He sees a giant orb glowing over Jerusalem, the Voice of God speaks to him, blesses him and he returns home.

He picks the Oriflame as his symbol, the fire of God, that leads him to victory.
