We are announcing the 2022-2023 JNF / NBN Ma'alot Grant Program. The committee developed new, and we believe, clearer guidelines. They can be found on the revised application form at www.jnf.org/maalot and also are listed below! I urge you to read what content is expected. Some of the key points are:

• Programs must be Israel Centric – not simply Jewish-themed.

• Budgets must be detailed with all expense and revenue items detailed.

• Speakers will only be funded if the person is identified by name, topic, how it relates to your planned programs, and the actual cost.

• Ma'alot grants are not to be used for food, paying staff salaries, purchasing capital equipment, marketing, advertising, or developing curriculum.

• Many sections ask that you LIST the key points. Quality of content rather than quantity are what we need.

• A review by the Executive Director is now required. If that person cannot understand the program, neither can the committee.

• The target audience by age groups and expected participation must be listed.

You are welcome to submit an application for a new program. The committee meets periodically, and applications are reviewed on a "first-in, first-reviewed" basis.
