

Expired Domain

"[Expired domain](#) name" refers to the situation that occurs when a website's "domain registration period," which is the period during which a website's domain name is registered, expires and is not renewed by its owner. The domain name registration period is usually renewed once a year and expires if payment is not made or there is a dispute with the registration service provider.

The consequences of an expired domain name can be:

Access Is Denied: An expired domain name may prevent access to the website. In this case, users cannot access the site using the domain name.

Service Discontinues: When a domain name expires, it is usually suspended for a period of time and may then be shut down completely. During this period, all services to the domain may be interrupted.
