If steamcmd doesn't work on freebsd, then it won't work anyway. Linux and freebsd do not exist in the same way.

Similar stuff was tried in the past. One thing that caused a lot more problems was epollmossing from freebsd Linux layer. This was added in freebsd 11. I don't know if it will be ported back to any of the freebsd10 based releases.

This would work best on a vanilla librebsd 11 or Linux VM on freenas 10 system. If you need something stable and you prefer your filesystem to be less stable, you can use Linux.
