IMPORTANT DETAILS

- The festival will take place on 6th & 7th April 2019 at The Container Yard
- Tickets are on sale at R50 - buy tickets at www.vwvivation.co.za for either Saturday or Sunday and your R50 ticket will be converted into a free R50 food and drink voucher upon arrival.
- There will be loads of spot prizes up for grabs throughout the day for ticket holders who arrive between 1pm and 3pm.
- No under 18's.
- Tickets are limited for each day, so fans need to buy them quickly.
- Note: You can buy a maximum of four tickets (one for you and up to three for your friends). Each ticket needs to be assigned to a unique email address at the time of purchase. Each person will be sent their ticket individually to the email address supplied (so make sure it's correct).
- You can only get a ticket for either Saturday or Sunday, not both days.
- The event hashtag is #VIVOnation.
- VW VIVOnation is proudly partnered with YFM and Trace Urban.

FAQs

What do I need to get in?

Just bring your ticket (either printed or on your phone – the bar code must be visible to scan) and proof of ID (drivers licence or ID card/book). No under 18's will be allowed entry.

Can I give my ticket to someone else?

You can only transfer your ticket within the ticket transfer window period, which will be announced on VW's social channels. Ticket transfer can only be done on the Howler registration page where tickets were purchased.

What time does the festival start and end?

Saturday 6 April: doors open at 1pm and close at 9pm. Activations and entertainment kicks off from 1pm.

Sunday 7 April: doors open at 1pm and close at 8pm. Activations and entertainment kicks off from 1pm.

Tickets are valid for either day as indicated on the ticket, not for the whole weekend.

Artist performances also start from 1pm and run until closing time. Performance times will be available at the festival and are subject to change.

Can I buy a VIP ticket?

There are no VIP tickets for sale. These are for invited guests only.

Where can I park?

Parking is VERY LIMITED and only available in designated parking areas. We strongly encourage everyone to SHARE THE RIDE and carpool with friends to limit the number of cars at the event. Please do not drink and drive.

A Park & Ride facility is being investigated and more information will be released soon.

What facilities will be there?

The festival will have toilets and other essential facilities available. There will be a disabled toilet available, however no disabled viewing deck. It is important to note that it's an outdoor container yard and the grounds are very uneven. However, there will be seating and shaded areas available.

There will be loads of great food stalls and bars to stay refreshed and fuelled.

There will be no ATMs available, bring cash or your card to top up your cashless wristband.

How does payment work at the festival?

Howler is a cashless payment system and the VW #VIVOnation Festival will be 100% cashless. This means you can only buy food, drinks and other items using the cashless wristbands you will receive on entry. You can load money onto your cashless wristband before the festival (on www.howler.co.za) or at the festival at one of the top-up stations using cash or card. Load as much money as you need and you can load as many times as you want.

Remember: everyone who comes to VW VIVOnation will have their R50 ticket price converted into a free voucher on entry to use at the event.

How do cash-outs work?

On-site cash-outs will be available at Howler stations until 8pm on Saturday and 7pm on Sunday. Online cash-outs will be available 72 hours after the event.

What can I bring in?

- Sunscreen and caps
- Cash and cards to top up your cashless wristband
- Your party vibe

What can't I bring in?

- No liquids or food of any kind can be brought into the festival. There will be loads of awesome food stalls and bars to buy from.
- No cooler boxes/bags
- No glass
- No chairs or umbrellas
- No weapons

Will I be allowed to exit and return to the festival?

Unfortunately no pass-outs will be allowed.
