Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

#4 ANGEL NATION closed from a long way out of it in the OSS Super Final to be the runner-up to Pemberton on October 17th at 76-1. He got away eighth from post-six and came his back-half in 55.3 and a final quarter of 27.2. He was beaten by almost four lengths but that came against the best three-year-old trotter in Canada and possibly beyond. It would not be fair to call that last effort an anomaly, as this gelding also raced well to be fifth in the final OSS Gold event on October 8th. He gets to face an infinitely easier group tonight and retains the services of James MacDonald. He is our clear top choice to kick off the card.

#3 MOON BRIDGE finished second to Oney Hall in NW5 in his latest and that rival went on to win his fourth in a row against an even more difficult group his next start. Prior to that effort, this colt also raced in the OSS Super Final and had to settle for seventh after coming up empty in the stretch. He has earned just over \$23,000 this season and that is a far cry from the \$200,989 that he made as a rookie last year but should enjoy the company he keeps tonight. He looks like the clear cut second choice and one of the two that stand out from the rest in here.

#1 LEXUS MARKUS has hit the board in five of his last six with his only off the board finish coming in the OSS Grassroots Final. He was only beaten a nose in NW2 last time and has seemed to turn the corner in the latter part of the season. He runs into a pair of bearcats in the two above tonight but can still hit the ticket.

#7 ARCHIES STAR was purchased by his current ownership group since his latest effort and now moves to the barn of Tim Cherwaiko. This gelding enjoyed some success in the early parts of the OSS Grassroots season but failed to make the final. He might take a forward step with the change of scenery and gets Scott Young at the controls.

#2 BEACH DEMON raced against his usual style last time when had to leave from the trailing post and got away seventh in the extended earnings version of NW2. He was never able to get into the race and came his back-half in 54.4 with a final quarter of 27.2. He gets his nose on the gate tonight from an inside draw and this looks like a spot where he might be able to run this field of their feet. He sports all kinds of early speed and should be rolling early. The pick.

#5 PERSEUS SEELSTER made his first start for Richard Moreau in his latest and failed to move forward on the final turn. He ended up fading back to ninth but might be better in his second start of new connections. He figures to offer a fair price and looks like a solid play underneath.

#8 CARD SWAP made a miscue just after the start of the Autumn Series at Western Fair. He was a handy winner in the second leg of that series two starts back. This gelding has progressed well and now gets Jody Jamieson for the first time in his career.

#7 WIND BLOWN moved first-over last time to make the lead and then then faded to sixth in the stretch. This gelding has good speed off the gate and should be forwardly placed. He can grab a share.

#6 BETTER BE DONNA N sat in the three-hole for much of the mile last time and was fed racetrack by Drury in the stretch to be a fast closing fourth under the wire. She was an easy front-end winner two starts back in NW5000L and three of her four wins on the year have come well above this class, including a victory in the Preferred on July 17th. She should be brave off her latest effort and will likely be put into play again off the gate tonight. Top call.

#7 MAJOR LEAGUE N boasted her usual early foot last week when sent to the lead by Hensley just past the quarter pole but was unable to go the distance, as she did two weeks ago in NW8000L5. This mare ended up fading to be third but is more than capable of wiring this group at her best.

#8 BOADICEA might be the best in here but is coming off a concerning effort and will also have to work from an outside post in the eight-hole. She raced well two starts back to be second beaten a head but then disappointed at 85 cents to the dollar last time with her usual pilot in Filion back in the sulky. #2 NICE KITTY HANOVER tried to come from way out of it last time when she got away ninth of the gate from the eight-hole. She was already more than 17 lengths out of it when the field hit the quarter pole. She ended up fifth-over on and was never able to find her stride until it was far too late. This filly was flying under the wire, but it was only good enough for a fifth-place finish and was unable to replicate her impressive closing victory two starts back. She came her back-half in 56.1 and her final quarter in 27.4 over a track that was graded one second off by the judges. She draws a much better post position tonight and figures to be closer in what will hopefully be conditions more conducive for her closing style. We expect this filly to bounce back tonight.

#7 BAYWATCHING was our best bet in her latest and barely took a forward step in the first-over position. It was her first start for Ron MacDonald and she was following the same path of Dabarndawgswatchin, who had won two in a row and then most recently finished third in the final of the Harvest Series. Despite the underwhelming effort last time, we are not willing to fully give up on this one yet and the price should be much sweeter than the 5/2 offered last time.

#1 PATRICIA MAE has only missed the board once in her last six starts in the class. While she has not tasted victory since she won a NW1 event at Kawartha Downs on July 25th, she has managed to pick up a cheque in her last 12 starts. This is largely thanks to her early speed and ability to utilize that asset to sit favorable trips. She should be in the mix again.

#6 DOCS HARMONY raced fantastic two starts back in NW3 when she circled most of her rivals on the final turn to finish second to the heavily favored Sound Idea. She was sent first-over in her latest and was never able to get past Ms Machingbird, who was 37-1, for the place spot. She might get a piece.

#1 HEMI SEELSTER plunged down to the bottom condition after finishing no better than seventh in his last five. His recent form leaves a lot to be desired, but he has been racing against much better than who he will face tonight in here. This 35-time winner handily beat his foes in NW8000L5 on August 25th and won at this level on July 11th. He appears to be the best option in here but tread carefully if the price is too short.

#2 SHES GOT PIZAZZ has not had much luck in drawing a decent post position as of late, as she started from the second-tier in her latest and had the eight-hole or worse in three of her four starts prior to that. The last time she drew inside was on September 15th when she finished third in NW5000L5 and now she gets to drop from the bottom level. The last time this mare dropped down this low was on January 9th and that effort still stands as her only win of the season. She is one of the top contenders against this group and she was Henry's choice over our first and third choices.

#3 PINK PISTOL finished third in here last time after dropping down from NW5000L5. She sat an inside trip and held a significant margin on the fourth-place finisher. Her tactical speed always gives her a chance at this level, but we prefer the two above.

#9 ST JAMES GATE finished fourth in here last time when dropping down to the bottom condition and now comes off the lasix program for tonight's effort. He will have to overcome the dreaded nine-hole but is a deep closer, so it should not affect his chances too much. He can grab a share.

She had the best pace of the rest late in the mile and was at a big disadvantage with the slow half that was set up front. This mare was fantastic in her debut for Moreau three starts ago, when she won going away in 1:52.2 on October 2nd. She missed a couple of weeks before finishing fifth in here two starts back and now might be sitting on a big effort after her latest. She gets Filion back in the sulky tonight and is worth a play, especially if she offers a nice price.

#8 THE BANDIT QUEEN N was lights out in this class last week, winning by three lengths and pacing her mile in 1:52.2. She blasted home in 27.2 but was aided by a 29.4 second quarter breather. She won from this outside post position by a slim margin in here two starts back and has won four of her last five overall. The mare has not missed the board in any of her starts at Mohawk Park and merits respect. We will try the one above tonight, but it would not surprise us if this one triples up.

#2 TUAPEKA JESSIE N was locked and blocked in the stretch last time and had pace under the wire. She sat an inside trip in the three-hole and Jamieson tried to angle her out in the stretch but never really found clearance. This mare has picked up a cheque in nine of her 10 starts since arriving on the circuit and can hit the ticket in her second start with Jamieson at the controls.

#1 LYONS TILT HANOVER moves up to NW5 after just missing by a nose in NW3 last time. She has been no worse than second in her last six efforts at the big track, including a runner-up finish in the OSS Grassroots Final on October 10th. She has paced her final split in 27.3 or faster in her last six over this surface and should be flying late again.

#4 WALK IT TALK IT had the trailing post last time and moved up trapped on the pylons before Coulter angled him out in the stretch drive. He was stuck behind a wall of horses and came forward when he finally got clearance late in the mile. This gelding may have fared better if he got clearance when he had his momentum behind him and he is an intriguing option in here, especially on the bottom end of the exotics.

#1 P H IMPULSE had no chance last time from the nine-hole in NW2, as he got away dead last off the gate and was more than 17 lengths out of it by the time the field hit the quarter pole. He came his back-half in 54.4 and his final panel in 27.2 in making steady progress throughout the mile to finish sixth. He might be able to get a slice in here.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the supervision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes
 Effective January 1st 2012
 CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:
Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

Smoking Regulations

The Government of Ontario is committed to improving the health of residents through the implementation of the *Smoke-Free Ontario Act*. Recent changes to the Act, which came into effect on January 1, 2015, further restrict the use of tobacco products in restaurants and bar patios. Smoking is now prohibited in all areas where food is served or sold or offered for consumption or in areas that are operated in conjunction with an area where food and drink is served or sold. The City of Toronto has also enacted restrictions on smoking in public places by requiring that smoking is not permitted within a 9 metre radius of an entrance or exit to a public building. Please refer to signage posted throughout the facility and the site to determine where smoking is permitted.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3, PICK 4 AND PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 3, Pick 4 and Pick 5 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three, four or five successive races specified for the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3, Pick 4 and Pick 5 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website. The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
