Minehut is the best free server hoster. However, I have heard people complain about being unable to join without an online owner. This can easily be resolved by joining Minehut's lobby (minehut.com), and then doing "/join server name". In about half an minute, the server will be up. Sidenotes - People living in Oceania will experience high levels of ping due to minehut's American data centre. A single server can host 10 players, making it ideal for small groups of friends. Link

- 2. Idleyhost \* Idleyhost \* Idleyhost has a reputation for being a competent hoster. However, many things can bring it down due its poor performance. The data centres are located in Germany, which gives you a lot of ping. However, you will have to keep trying to host because there is only so many spots. The server can be run 24/7 if the server tab is open. The downtime can range from 30 minutes up to 70 percent of the day. This server hoster is relatively new so it's likely to improve. This hoster is ideal for hosting a 24/7 server but has poor performance. Link
- 3. Aternos \* \*\* \* Ah, Aternos. You can host Java and Bedrock simultaneously. The server's RAM will increase the more people playing. It's hosted in America which is great for most people. It allows for more customization than any of them. However, it is not able to run 24/7. The server cannot run 24/7. Users must wait in a queue and then join the server. Otherwise, the server will be offline for 3 minutes. Minecraft servers This is a reliable and trustworthy server hoster.
