Please briefly present the organisation.				





SALT Youth Association is an independent, democratic, non-political and youth-oriented social initiative since 2011 and in July 2019 gained association status. With a large potential of members and followers throughout Turkey, aiming youth to take active roles in the society with the idea of "for the youth with the youth", thus, voluntarily organizing social and cultural activities at local, national and international levels led by youth workers, volunteers, students, trainers, and project experts who are active in art, media, training and project management. SALT directs its work mainly towards the target group consisted of especially socially and economically disadvantaged young people aged 18-35.

SALT Youth Association is a member of Youth Organizations Forum (National Youth Council), Anna Lindh Foundation and Balance and Supervision Network.

We are aiming to establish new partnerships with individuals and organizations which are working in the youth works, Media, Rights and human rights-based field, take responsibility to be work as a volunteer and develop their experiences and activities which will be implemented via different techniques.

And also, we have 10 years experienced board members who have organized more than 30 projects in youth work and youth field which are about:

Depending on the project theme, SALT can reflect the previous experiences and know-how before, during and after the project by sending valuable Turkish participants to the event. SALT Youth Association has a wide range of profiles of members from all over Turkey, so participants would fit the theme of the project.

As for the theme of the project, SALT Youth members are open to various topics, and we select our participants according to their backgrounds and motivation. Our board consists of 16 active youth workers and they are all active in projects. SALT Youth Association members, (about 50 registered) come from different parts of Turkey, but mostly İzmir. They are mostly university students who are interested and skilled in various areas from media, management, culture to social inclusion, outdoor activities, digital workshops or social activities.

SALT Youth Association has a well-organized system to get applications and select the participants for each project. We put our projects online on our social media, and our members can log in with their individual user accounts to fill in the application form of the projects. Then, dozens of candidate applications are evaluated by the project committees and the executive board of the organization. Finally, several online and face-to-face meetings are held with participants and





they are prepared for the projects thoroughly. Then, the board or project committee evaluates and chooses the best participants as possible according to their profile, background, skills, and motivation.

From the moment the participants are selected, they are monitored, advised and assisted during the whole process of the project, especially during the preparation phase.

SALT has a media workshop titled "Salt Media Community", and we give short pre-departure training to participants about the use of media in projects. We also organize dissemination activities in this workshop office with the participation of our young members.
