Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#5 STEUBEN HANOVER will be making his five-year-old debut, after winning four of 21 last season with just over \$90,000 in earnings. We last saw him last November when he disappointed as the favorite at this level when he was interfered with down the backside causing him to make a break in stride. He comes into this off two qualifying preps and was looking strong in his most recent on March 18th when he trotted up powerfully to be second under the wire to High Gear No Fear, getting the better of both Southwind Avenger and Cindy Lynn. This gelding is the best trotter in this contest when at his best and will be difficult to beat if he is ready to roll off the bench.

#2 TRIX AND STONES tried to come from well out of it last time and had to settle for fifth. His chances were diminished when the fractions up front were tepid with the leader trotting a middle half in 59.1. This son of Trixton had some of the best late legs and trotted his back-half in 57 seconds flat with a final split in 28.1. He only missed by a nose to Buzz two starts back and was a winner in the bottom condition on March 5th. The inside might help him get off the wings better and he picks up Jamieson with McNair committed to drive Memo.

#1 OH SO PINE was a winner at the level below this last time when he moved first-over on the final turn and forged past the heavy favorite Wild And Crazy Guy in the stretch. He drew off from his rivals in the stretch before being shut down by MacDonald just before the wire. This gelding has now hit the board all three of his efforts since returning from a stint stateside and MacDonald opts to stick with him over three others in the race.

#10 SOUTHWIND AVENGER will be making his first start of 2020 after being away for nearly four months. He spent his last five starts in tougher spots than this and was second at this level on November 2nd. This gelding will have to overcome the second-tier and a smaller share is expected this time around.

#6 UHTRED was a lights out winner in his debut on the circuit in his first start out of the barn of Carmen Auciello last week. He went to the early lead from this same starting spot and dropped a 27 second flat third quarter on his rivals before pacing away in the stretch to score by as much as he pleased. It was his first start back after being off for more than five months and he might even be better now that he has an effort under his belt. He only fits the class because he is four years of age but does face a much tougher group in this NW16000L5 event than he did in NW5 in his latest. This gelding appeared to have lots left in the tank last time and we want no part in siding against him. Top call.

#4 MAJOR CUSTARD has been the runner-up to Beyond Better in his first two starts on the circuit and was pacing well under the wire when he came home in 27 seconds flat in his latest. He sat an inside trip in the three-hole for most of the mile and then angled to the outside around rivals in the final eighth of a mile. There was certainly no shame in finishing second to that winner and he retains Jamieson for tonight's tilt. Using underneath.

#5 REAL SURREAL finished third just behind the one above to Beyond Better last week in his first start back after six months on the sidelines. He came his back-half in 55 seconds flat and paced his final split in 27.1. This gelding was an impressive winner at this level on September 11th when he scored going away in 1:50.2 in his third start off the claim for Moreau. He probably got a lot out of his latest and looms a danger.

#2 POSEIDON SEELSTER had won four in a row in NW5 before the shutdown and now returns to the races to make his four-year-old debut. He comes into this off a rock-solid qualifying effort where he won by 13 lengths in 1:53 flat on the heels of a final quarter in 26 seconds. This gelding gets lasix for the first time in his career and cannot be dismissed.

He looked a lot more like the horse he was at the end of last season, when he won three in a row at this level by a combined seven lengths. This gelding disappointed as the favorite when he returned off a three-month layoff two weeks ago but that should not have come as a shock as when he had won off the bench in the past it came when he had a qualifier under his belt. This winner of nearly \$1.4M in his career lays over this field when anywhere near his best and should romp again tonight in this compact field.

#4 WHEELS ON FIRE had won three in a row on the front-end going into his latest but went to the halfway point a full second faster than in any of those victories and as such faded in the stretch to finish fifth. He should have no trouble getting to the lead again tonight and can stick around for a big piece of it if McNair can steal the second or third panel. This gelding was not able to bang home last time but will be our clear second choice in the hopes of him having more left in the tank for the stretch drive tonight.

#6 ROCKME ROLLME was sitting the two-hole to the one above and angled off the cones at the top of the turn to follow Sintra. He ended up just getting past the leader and held off a late charge from Points North but was beaten for the place spot by Nocturnal Bluechip who slipped up the inside after sitting in the three-hole. This gelding would have likely been second if he stayed on the pylons and should get every chance to land on the ticket again.

#2 POINTS NORTH was gapped out in the second-over position on the final turn when Sintra accelerated away from him and this allowed the one above to slip to the outside ahead of him. He did his best pacing in the final sixteenth and finished three across the track for the place spot. This gelding had to settle for fourth and has now finished in that spot in his last two at this level.

It was his first start off the claim for Carmen Auciello and this gelding has now finished in the runner-up in his last three at the level. He will get the better post position of the two this week, but we will still opt to utilize him underneath.

#9 MILITARY SECRET returns to the level where he has won three of his last four after trainer Mitch Tierney moved him up to carry an optional tag of \$45,000 last week in his first start off the claim. He not only had to take on much tougher competition but was also hampered with the dreaded nine-hole. This gelding got away last off the gate and was unable to improve a position. He will have to work from that starting spot again tonight but should at least enjoy the company he keeps.

#7 LEGAL BETTOR was scratched due to lameness on March 13th but raced well to be second the week before that at 23-1 from the outermost post. He has not raced in a few weeks but might be able to add some value to the bottom end of the exotics.

#2 GRAY DRAGON was the runner-up last week when he sat the two-hole to a pumped-up winner in Uhtred. He did well to maintain his position and finished two lengths clear of the one above under the wire. This son of Dragon Again has shown steady improvement through his three starts this season and cannot be discounted today. He is one of the main chances in the contest.

He finished third in NW25000L5 two starts back and was only beaten by a neck to Rockme Rollme. This marks his third start back off a lengthy layoff but there is some concern over him being in for the tag in this contest. He has a winning chance if anywhere near his best but will be one of the two we zero in on utilizing under our top selection.

#6 EAST END has spent his last two at the Preferred level and picked up shares in tougher condition classes in his three tries before that. He was a winner in this class in his final start before the shutdown and the softer competition might wake him up tonight. This gelding cannot be dismissed but we prefer the ones above.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the supervision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
