Advocacy Initiatives

- Discussions for opioid-related legislation began as early as 2017: hearings, RFIs, briefings, round table discussion etc
 - AAOS monitored all developments and provided input and feedback along the way
- · Feb. 2018: Letter to Senate Finance
- March 2018: Letter to House Ways & Means
 - Ways and Means Committee Report quoted AAOS policy
- April 2018: Letter to Senate HELP
- April 2018: Letter to Energy & Commerce

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Advocacy Initiatives

AAOS supported two pieces of legislation:

- HR 3528: Every Prescription Conveyed Securely Act
 would require electronic prescriptions for
 controlled substances
- 2. HR 4236: The MONITOR Act
 - would establish minimum standards for Prescription Drug Monitoring Programs

NOLC Opioid Discussions

- Opioid policy was one of the 'asks' at NOLC Hill Day on June 7, 2018
 - AAOS members talked about various legislative proposals and explained the AAOS position on prescription limits, electronic prescribing, and mandatory opioid CME.
- 412 scheduled meetings with members of the House, Senate, and staffers
- 280 orthopaedic surgeons participated

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Final Opioid Package

On September 28, 2018 the final opioid package (HR 6), passed the House. $\label{eq:constraint}$

AAOS wins in bill:

- · No limits on prescriptions
- Every Prescription Conveyed Securely Act included

On October 3^{rd,} HR 6 passed the Senate
