

Command Overview

- 1. On 8 Sep 20 the trial began of five Somali nationals suspected of carrying out a piracy attacked on the Korean flagged fishing vessel 'Adria' in April 2019. This attack was the last confirmed piracy incident in the Indian Ocean region (see media article d).
- 2. The International Maritime Security Construct (IMSC) are holding a Shipping Industry Stakeholders Conference on 16 Sept 20. Anyone wishing to register for this event should contact: Christopher.Perry@me.navy.mil
- 3. UKMTO (Dubai) has resumed the provision of Maritime Security briefings to merchant vessels alongside ports in the UAE. All visits follow published Industry guidance in relation to COVID-19 and our officers will comply with individual commercial shipping companies restrictions as required.
