WHYALLA STEEL TRANSFORMATION.

The \$600 million transformation of the Whyalla Steelworks was announced in December by Executive Chairman, Sanjeev Gupta. Work has begun on the collection of geotechnical data and planning work has commenced with manufacturing partner Danieli on early design elements.

Danieli, together with China's CISDI Engineering Co - who are working on the new Pulverised Coal Injection plant - will be responsible for the first stage of Mr Gupta's \$600 million Whyalla Transformation Plan.



SIMEC MINING

(Part of the GFG Alliance group) has received approval for two new mining leases that will see expansion of the Iron ore mines in the Middleback Ranges. The Iron Sultan mine will supply the Whyalla steelworks while the Iron Warrior mine will produce 1.5 million tonnes of iron ore for export annually. It is expected that the Iron Sultan mine will develop a hybrid pellet feed plant which will see the price of making steel at the Whyalla blast furnace drop significantly.



DPTI

\$200 Million Joy Baluch AM bridge and upgrade to existing bridge and approaches on the Augusta Highway. Expressions of interest are being called Q1 2019.





BHP

Olympic Dam Expansion - BHP's proposal to increase Olympic Dam copper production by 75% is a step closer with the SA Government granting major development status. The \$3 billion proposal would lift copper production to 350,000 tpa.



OZ MINERALS

Carrapateena Mine Development - OZ Minerals' \$916 m Carrapateena copper gold mine construction is well under way and on target to process first ore late 2019. OZ Minerals' commitment to local supplier engagement is producing opportunities in the USG.



NYRSTAR

Nyrstar begins an exciting new chapter in a stronger position as an independent company within the Trafigura group, one of the world's largest commodity trading houses. There is now opportunity for Nyrstar, a global multi-metals business to realise its full potential.



RENEWABLE ENERGY

The Upper Spencer Gulf and Far North is the centre of renewables investment with more than 12 active proposals for solar, wind, pumped hydro and battery storage projects. We'll feature several projects under construction and others progressing through approvals and financing.



ELECTRANET

Hill2Hill and EP Transmission projects.

ElectraNet is advancing the new \$270 million Hill2Hill transmission line connecting the USG and OZ Minerals' Prominent Hill mine and recently announced plans to construct a new \$240 m Eyre Peninsula transmission line.



PIRIE MEATS

A \$60 million livestock abattoir near Port Pirie is in the final approvals stage. Pirie Meats is expecting construction to start before the end of 2019. The facility will create 215 full-time jobs and another 150 secondary jobs linked to the project. Processing at the new facility is expected to commence in 2020.



LEIGH CREEK ENERGY

The Leigh Creek in-situ gasification project has achieved a significant milestone demonstrating environmentally sustainable commercial gas flows from its Pre-Commercial Demonstration plant at its Leigh Creek site and announcing a Maiden 2P Reserve certification of 1,153PJ - similar in size to BHP's East Coast gas reserves and larger than Beach Petroleum's. The project is now progressing toward full commercialisation.
