#### CAPE TOWN PHILHARMONIC ORCHESTRA

The Cape Town Philharmonic Orchestra is a dynamic, multi-functional, full-time professional orchestra, continuing a fine tradition of over a century of orchestral music in Cape Town. In addition to its diverse concert repertoire, the orchestra also performs for operas, ballets and musicals; engages in tours and recordings; and is the driving-force behind a variety of youth development and education projects.

The Cape Town Philharmonic Orchestra invites applications from suitably qualified South African citizens or Permanent Residents of South Africa for the position of:

#### **DEPUTY CONCERTMASTER**

1<sup>st</sup> Violin sitting No. 2 and No. 3; leading as required.

This is a full-time (100%) position. The Deputy Concertmaster is required to lead the orchestra in the absence of the Concertmaster or a Guest Concertmaster. This position requires a violinist of the highest calibre, who displays excellent leadership and team-work skills, as well as being reliable and professional at all times. The musician will also be required to participate in the Cape Town Philharmonic Orchestra's various education and youth development initiatives.
