
WORKPLACE ADVISORY SUPPORT IN THE CONTEXT OF COVID-19

Comprehensive COVID-19 Policies

Development of tailor-made policies and guidelines for company preparedness and response strategy; support to the managers and workers with ensuring the safety of risk points at the workplace and case management



Adapting Company Premises

Recommendations for the improvement of all different types of company premises (offices, factories, construction sites, etc.), aiming to mitigate COVID-19 transmission among workers



Infection Prevention and Control (IPC)

Implementation of IPC strategies to prevent and limit infections & transmission among workers, improvement of hand hygiene, support for cleaning, disinfection and waste managment protocols, processes, workflows, installations and devices



Procurement of Equipment & Supplies and Use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Ensure the provision of adequate PPE, equipment, consumables & devices; support to the procurement, installation & remote maintenance of goods essential in the context of Covid-19



Communication and Community Support

Produce information to families & communities of workers with visual and culturally adapted messages on pandemic, prevention, measures, hand hygiene, disinfection, physical distancing & transport arrangements; advising on collateral issues like violence within families
