TITLE

The Right to Reproductive Freedom with Protections for Health and Safety

- "Reproductive Freedom"**
- = Child Sex Trade
 - = Prostitution
 - = Pedophilia
 - = Abortion until birth
 - = Gender confusion

No Age Restriction
Children can decide what sex/gender they are without parental notification, consent, or involvement. INCLUDING selling of one's own body for sex trade.

SUMMARY

The Amendment would amend Article I of the Ohio Constitution by adding Section 22, titled "The Right to Reproductive Freedom with Protections for Health and Safety."

The Amendment provides that:

"Not limited to" means anything beyond the text dealing with sex or sex organs

"Least restrictive" Legally means if the state can do less, they are required to do less.

All protections for babies in the womb for the first 5 months of pregnancy GONE!

1. Every individual has a right to make and carry out one's own reproductive decisions, including but not limited to decisions on contraception, fertility treatment, continuing one's own pregnancy, miscarriage care, and abortion.

2. The State shall not, directly or indirectly, burden, penalize, prohibit, interfere with, or discriminate against either an individual's voluntary exercise of this right or a person or entity that assists an individual exercising this right, unless the State demonstrates that it is using the least restrictive means to advance the individual's health in accordance with widely accepted and evidence-based standards of care.

3. However, abortion may be prohibited after fetal viability. But in no case may such an abortion be prohibited if in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient's treating physician it is necessary to protect the pregnant patient's life or health.

4. As used in this Section, "Fetal viability" means "the point in a pregnancy when, in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient's treating physician, the fetus has a significant likelihood of survival outside the uterus with reasonable measures. This is determined on a case-by-case basis"; and "State" includes any governmental entity and political subdivision.

5. This Section is self-executing. "Political subdivision" means anyone the state delegates it's authority to: including all cities, counties, municipalities, state-run healthcare, & education.

Dealing with Sex or Sex Organs

All restriction is on the state

That means an adult can exploit a youth or child legally.

Abortion up to birth legalized

Legally means "Emotional Health" "Mental Health"

HOW THIS WILL LEGALIZE PROSTITUTION:

So if a woman claims, "It is my reproductive decision to have sex and get paid for it." The state can not make any law against it. "The State shall not, directly or indirectly, burden, penalize, prohibit, interfere with, or discriminate against" this newfound "right."

HOW THIS WILL LEGALIZE PEDOPHILIA:

If an adult can convince a child, it is his or her reproductive decision to have sex with him, and can convince the child to say it is his or her "own reproductive choice" then the state can not make any law against that.

HOW THIS WILL LEGALIZE CHILD SEX TRADE:

This all becomes legal because the Amendment says, "The State shall not, directly or indirectly, burden, penalize, prohibit, interfere with, or discriminate against either: An individual's voluntary exercise of this right or A person or entity that assists an individual exercising this right,"
