Where can I find cats?

There are no animal adoption centers in Minecraft. You'll need to find a stray kitten to adopt in the wild. Cats are easily found. Stray cats spawn in villages with at least one villager and four beds. For every four beds in a village, cats will produce (up to 10), so you'll likely have a range of colors to pick from in an average village.

Black cats can also be found around witch huts in swamps.

The Bedrock Edition is the most well-known version and it features black cats which are more likely to appear at full moons.

Step 1 to calm a cat, collect some raw cod or salmon from a nearby lake or river.

Step 2: Get the fish and slowly approach the stray cat. The raw fish can be used on the cat who is hesitant.

Step 3: Continue feeding the cat raw fish until it has hearts above its head. This is a sign that it is being tamed. It is likely that you will need to feed it several times before it can like you, so make sure to stock up on fish before you try this.

Step 4: Once the cat has had enough food, the hearts will disappear and the cat will be given a collar. Now you have a cat as a pet.

Cat behavior

Once you've successfully tamed your cat and it follows you around wherever you go. If you get lost in the midst of your cat, don't fret - they can teleport to a player that is 12 blocks away. Cats that have been trained are not able to remain still unless instructed to. They will roam the surrounding area unless they are instructed to. You can command a cat to sit and keep it in one place -- if you wanted an indoor cat within your home, for instance.

When in a house cats will climb onto furniture on their own. You can often find them perched on top of chests, beds, and furnaces. Like real-life cats, cats in Minecraft are sometimes able to interfere with your plans and render chests, furnaces, etc., unusable until you get them moved. If they get into anything you don't want them playing with, you can either push them away, lure them away using raw fish, or remove blocks beneath the surface to help them move.

If a person goes to bed at night, there's a chance the cat that is tamed will sleep near them. There's a good chance that a pet cat will bring you a gift when they awake. They may bring string, raw chicken and rabbit's feet among others.
