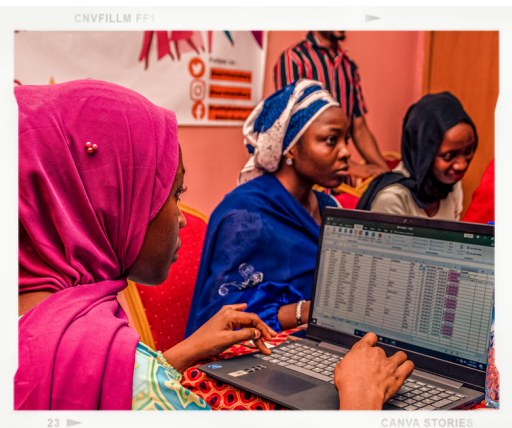
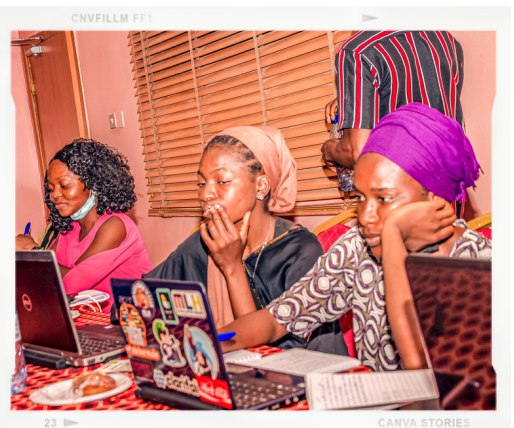

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

International Women's Day is a day, globally celebrating women's social, economic, cultural, and political achievements. The day also marks a call to action for accelerating gender parity in line with the 2022 International Women's Day theme: "Gender Equality Today for a Sustainable Tomorrow". According to The United Nations Women survey conducted in 2020, about 43.5 percent of female children were given out in marriage, 17.4 percent suffered from lifetime physical or secular intimate partner's violence. Women holds 20% of Executive Positions in Nigeria, but only 33% are in the workforce (Africa Business Insider, 2021), Women are underrepresented in politics, 7 out of 109 senators and 22 of the 360 House of Representatives are women.

In academics, we have 1,802 women professors out of 11,877 professors in Nigeria (Statistic, 2022), etc. It's generally believed that Gender equality is a cornerstone for development in Nigeria, together with the elimination of Gender Inequality and with the critical issues to: - Celebrate women's achievements. -Raise awareness about women's equality. -Lobby for accelerated gender parity. -Fundraise for female-focused charities etc.

To commemorate IWD2022, the girl code boot camp is aimed at equipping young girls from the ages of 15-27 with ICT skills which will help them seize work opportunities across the world. The programme intends to contribute to achieving SDGs1 – No Poverty, SDGs4 – Quality education, SDGs8 – Decent work and economic Growth SDGs10 – Reduced inequalities. This project is also an avenue of self-realization and will be used as a tool to prevent and counter problems faced by women and girls through peer talks, mentorship and career talk, thereby building an Equitable, diverse and inclusive environment that will enable young girls to become pioneers of progress in tech with their growth unfettered by gender constraints.

The approach of the Girl code boot camp project is to create a network of women with a desire to do their own quota in responding to the challenges faced by women.

GIRL CODE BOOT CAMP occurs annually, usually to mark international Women's day .

Women form a significant part of its demography with recent statistics putting its youthful population aged between 0 to 24 years at 63.1% alone.

Despite this formidable percentage, women are left behind overtime. with their exclusion from opportunities, governance and a host of other things.

To reduce this gap and improve access of young women to global opportunities, Salma Attah Foundation for women and girls support (SAFWGS) with support from Wisdom ICT solutions organized a two day training programme for young Nigerian women aged between 15 to 27 years old .

A selection of 21 women was made in the final shortlist for the 2022 GIRLCODE BOOT CAMP Programme.

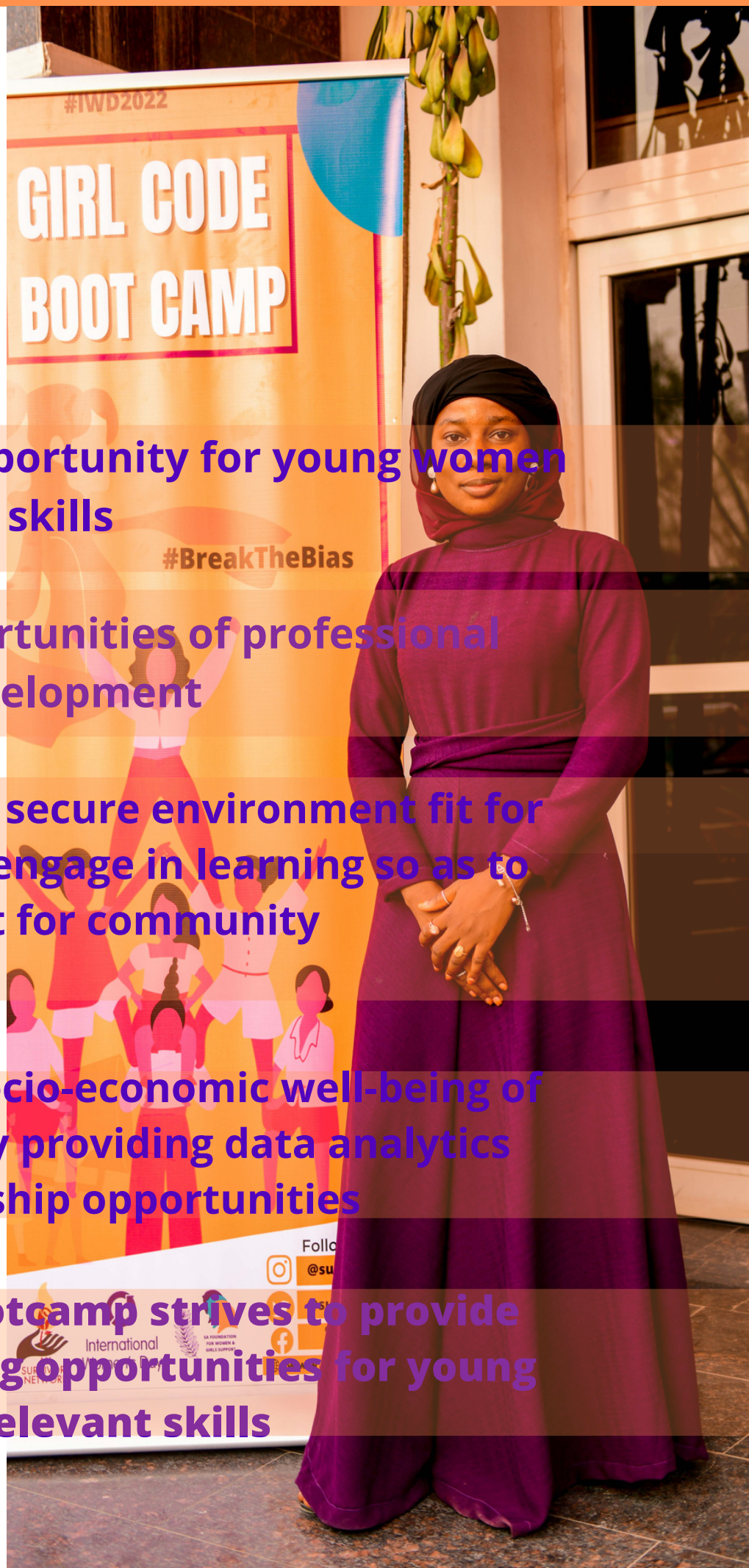


Eligibility Criteria

- The Girl Code Bootcamp strives to provide adequate learning opportunities for young girls to develop relevant skills

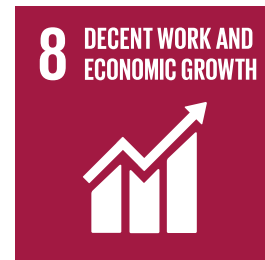
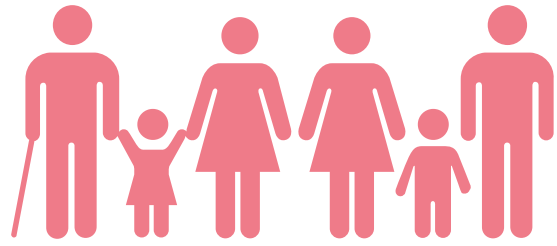
