

3 Bean Stew

Some days we want comfort food. And some days we just don't have the time or energy for a nice rich dish. This bean stew seeks to offer a quick and easy alternative to your comfort food woes. It's nice and thick and wonderfully filling. I do advise serving it with a side of a crusty bread like ciabatta so that you can sop it up at the end. It's absolutely a fall or

winter meal, but It's not going to leave you hanging in the summertime either.

Ingredients:

- 2 TBSP (30 mL) oil
- 1 chopped onion
- 1 chopped green bell pepper
- 1 chopped yellow bell pepper •
- 3¹/₂ cups (840 mL) chicken broth
- 1¼ cups (250 g) diced tomato •
- 1 TBSP (10 g) chopped green chile pepper •
- 3¾ cups (230 g) black beans •
- 2 cups (125 g) pinto beans •
- 3 ³/₄ cups (230 g) kidney beans •
- 1 cup (200 g) - rice

Directions:

- 1. cook your rice and beans. If you get canned beans that's fine too. But you want those cooked.
- 2. in a large soup pot put your oil, onions, and peppers. heat until the vegetables are softened.
- 3. add the broth, tomatoes, chile pepper, and the beans, stirring occasionally until heated through.
- 4. add the rice and let simmer until thickened slightly
- 5. dish into bowls and serve
