Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

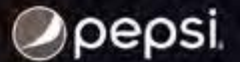

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#8 REAR VIEW claimed the show spot in this class last week and has now hit the board in all three of her starts since returning from the shutdown. She was travelling second-over in her latest and then had to take some air when the rival she was following briefly took a tuck in the two-hole. This mare came her back-half in 56.3 with a final panel of 28.4. She now gets reunited with Bob McClure, who booked off her last time in favor of Zarconia Seelster. Giving her the edge to kick off the card.

#6 KIWI FOCUS N has progressed nicely in her last three starts and was a winner at this level last time when she was handled aggressively by MacDonald. She was trying to find room in the stretch two starts back and then closed well to be second when she scooted up the cones late. This 27-time winner was rushed to the lead just past the halfway point in her latest and then held a comfortable margin the rest of the way to score in 1:54 flat. She has repeat potential.

#7 HOWMACFIESTY was a rock-solid winner at Grand River Raceway two starts back when she rocketed to the lead from the six-hole and made every call a winning one under no urging by Coulter. She raced well in defeat here last week when she was overland for part of the mile and then was the closest challenger to the one above as they approached the wire. This mare is in good form and merits consideration.

#4 BEHAVENMYSELF won back-to-back tries off the bench to earn heavy favoritism at this level last week but tired badly after getting taken over by our second choice before the halfway point. Something must have gone amiss because she paced her final quarter in 32.4 to finish last by a wide margin. She handily beat these horses in her previous two and might rebound tonight.

#7 SHESWILDNFREE was the runner-up in her latest to Nylander, who went a big mile from the first-over position. This mare sat in the three-hole for most of the journey and found room up the pylons in deep stretch to get past the leader Royalty Deal. She finished fourth to that rival two starts back after sitting a perfect trip, but that effort came in her first start off the bench in nearly a month. She is winless in her last four but has won five of ten this season and tonight looks like her best chance in a while to get back to her winning ways.

#5 PROFOUND PARAGON won 12 of 16 and banked over \$134,000 last season, which was capped off by winning the OSS Grassroots championship last fall. She has one win in four starts so far in her four-year-old season and that came in the Preferred at Trois Rivieres on May 23rd. This mare returned to Ontario last week to be third in the Preferred-2 at Georgian Downs and encountered some traffic trouble near the wire. She has six wins over this surface and might enjoy the move back to the big track tonight.

#1 ANGRY EYES has been a fringe player in her last three in the class but showed some life in the stretch last time when she was doing her best work in the shadow of the wire. She did not get clearance until extremely late and finished four-across the track for the runner-up position. This mare ended up finishing fifth, but it was a big step in the right direction. She could be dangerous, and the price might be right.

#4 NIMBUS DEO has not raced in over three months and now returns to the races for new connections out of the barn of Jean Tourigny. She has won eight of her 16 tries over this surface but will likely need a start or two before she is a win candidate.

#2 BEST HEAD WEST has hit the board in both of her efforts as a sophomore but has not yet tasted victory so far this season. She did not have much of a chance two starts back when she was closing hard into tepid fractions and need a back-half in 55 seconds flat with a final panel of 26.3 to claim the show spot. This filly then had the best late pace in her latest when she paced her final quarter in 27.3 to be second to Lady Arthur in the slop over a track that was two seconds off. She struck gold once last year and had to scratch out of the OSS Super Final due to sickness but looks primed to start off her stakes season on a winning note.

#4 SCARLETT HANOVER won six of 14 last season and banked nearly \$450,000. She was a multiple stakes winner, including the OSS Super Final, and was third in the Breeders Crown. This filly has two starts so far as a sophomore and failed to hit the board in either of those tries. She now returns to the barn of Ashleigh Hensley, where she enjoyed all six of her wins out of 12 starts last season.

#5 BET ON BECKY was a dominant winner in the first four starts of her career last season but was then put on the shelf after something went amiss in the Eternal Camnation. Three of those wins came at the OSS Gold level and each of them were of the easiest variety. She raced well in her sophomore debut to be second to Voelz Delight but then faded to be sixth in her latest after being used hard early. This filly might rebound with a better effort today, but we prefer the two one above.

#3 ANDRA DAY has raced well to pick up smaller shares in her first two starts as a sophomore. She won the first three starts of her career as a rookie and two of those contests came at the OSS gold level. This filly ended up banking over \$128,000 but appears to be in deep water in her first stakes engagement of the year.

He might enjoy the move back to the big track and now picks up the hot hands of James MacDonald for the first time in his career. This colt has hit the board in five of nine career starts and we are hoping he breaks through to find the winner's circle.

#7 CARTIERE was a \$16,000 yearling purchase at the London Selected sale that will now make his lifetime debut at three for trainer Carl Jamieson. He is out of a mare who has produced several winners of \$100,000 or more and he qualified well on June 10th where he got the better of the one below in the shadow of the wire after a sprinting home in 26.3. This gelding was scheduled to make his first start on June 18th but was scratched out of that contest due to sickness. His speed late in his morning prep was impressive and he might be ready to win at first asking.

#1 HESINCONTROL was an \$8,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale that will make the first start of his career for conditioner Lyle MacArthur. This colt matched strides with the one above in the stretch drive of their qualifier on June 10th and eventually gave up the lead to finishing second beaten a head. He sprinted his final panel in 26.4 in defeat and will now go postward under the lights for the first time nearly a month later. In a field where the ones that have experience are a combined 0 for 68, it might be wise to side with the ones with a clean slate.

#5 SAULSBROOK HERO made a miscue in his sophomore debut but then followed it up with a decent effort to be third in this class on June 24th. He paced his final panel in 26.4 and has hooked strong winners in each of his last two. This gelding merits consideration on the ticket.

#1 JODY has won three in a row to kick off her three-year-old season and has looked more impressive each time she steps on the racetrack. She blasted home in 26 seconds flat in her first start of the season to pace past her rivals like they were tied to the fence and then showed off her front-stepping ability when she paced her mile in 1:52.2 on the engine. This filly did not hit the board in two tries as a rookie and now takes a big step up in competition in tackling OSS gold foes for the first time. James MacDonald must think she is up to the challenge, as he opted to drive her over the one below. She merits respect.

#1 RUN DIRECTOR has not raced since last September when he finished fifth in the Preferred here at Mohawk Park but now returns to the races off two rock-solid qualifying victories. He won his most recent morning prep by nearly seven lengths going away in 1:55.2 and appears ready to roll for this six-year-old season. This son of Kadabra has 14 lifetime wins and more than \$600,000 in the bank. He has multiple wins at the Preferred level here at Mohawk Park and has never competed this low down the class ladder. He should be tough to beat if he can bring anything near his best.

#3 ZIG ZAG drops out of the Preferred ranks after back-to-back disappointing efforts at that level. He now gets big time class relief in this NW12000L5 event and will go postward with lasix for the second time in his career. This gelding loses Sylvain Filion to his stablemate above and gets Mario Baillargeon at the controls for tonight's tilt. He has not found his form since the return of racing but this is his best opportunity to get his confidence back.

#6 ODDS ON AMETHYST finished fourth in the Preferred in his latest and now gets some much-needed class relief after racing at that level in each of his last two. This gelding can be competitive against the tougher trotters on the circuit when he is at his absolute best, and he might be able to produce something like that in his fourth start back since the shutdown. #7 TRUFFLE DOG got up to beat the heavily favored Cadillac Bayama last week by a nose right on the wire. He moved first-over around the final turn and did not find his best stride until the final eighth of a mile when he surged to get up alongside the leaders. This gelding paced his back-half in 54.2 with a final quarter in 27 seconds flat. He might be able to build on that new lifetime mark (1:50.4) performance to come right back to be victorious in this higher earnings version of NW2. Top call.

#8 JIMMY CONNOR B was the easiest kind of winner on June 14th when he scored by five lengths in 1:52.2 but then ran into a monster in his follow-up effort on June 22nd. He was on the lead by a comfortable margin, but P L Ozzy blew by him at the top of the stretch and it might have broke this one's heart, as he faded to finish fourth under the line. This gelding has now missed a week between starts but might be able to rebound. He should not be ignored and will be our main player underneath.

#5 MUSTANG BEACH was the runner-up at this level in his latest and was a winner in the lower earnings version of this class two back. He has now hit the board in his last five starts and has come home in 27.1 or better in both of his tries as a sophomore. This gelding is not without a chance and can hit the ticket.

#6 BRILLIANT CORNERS was a lights out winner in his latest in the condition claimer ranks but now moves to this straight NW2 event. This is a much more difficult spot than where he raced in his latest and while the margin of victory and time will likely attract some attention, he will have to further improve for his new connections to have a chance. A smaller prize is expected.

#8 NYLANDER went a big mile first-over at this level last week when he was victorious in 1:54 flat. It was his first start back at Mohawk Park since he headed stateside for six starts at the Meadowlands during the lockdown. He set his lifetime mark of 1:52.2 south of the border on May 21st and that conditioning likely helped propel him to victory in his latest. This son of Muscle Hill is not always the prettiest going trotter but will be difficult to hold off if he can replicate his latest.

#6 ROYALTY DEAL was an easy winner in the first two starts of her four-year-old campaign but then floundered late in her most recent effort to blow up as the favorite at 45 cents to the dollar. She trotted more difficult splits in her latest with a middle-half of 57.2 and that is likely why she could only hang on for fourth under the wire. It will be interesting to see how she rebounds from that defeat but if she can get away with softer panels on the front-end, she might be return to her winning ways.

#3 MUSCLE DYNASTY returns to Mohawk Park for the first time since competing in the final of the William Wellwood Memorial last September. He has not had much success so far in his sophomore season but might enjoy the move back to these surroundings and now picks up Sylvain Filion for the first time in his career. He should not be dismissed and might be worth a look if the price is right.

#7 TOCCOA FALLS closed well to finish third last time and just missed getting up for the place spot over Sheswildnfree. He was flying under the wire and might take another step forward now that it is his third start back off a month-long layoff. This gelding is worth using on the bottom end of the exotics, but we prefer the ones above.

#7 ISLAND BEACH BOY progressed nicely with a much better effort in the second start of this sophomore campaign on June 24th in this class when he tried to split rivals late but was unable to get Century Hannibal. He paced his back-half in 54.4 and his final quarter in 26.3. This gelding now hooks a softer group at the level and might be able to find the winner's circle in the third start of his season. He gets our vote of confidence in the nightcap.

#4 SOUTHBEACH HANOVER is one of seven entrants that are not moving up from NW1 and this colt has picked up minor awards in his last two at the level. He was closing well to be fourth in the same race that the one above exits and might have an edge over some of the other contenders that have not yet been acclimated to this class. Using underneath.

#10 LANCASTER BOMBER is one of three that graduated from NW1 in their latest with a victory. This one was a winner by open lengths in 1:52 flat with a final panel of 26.3. He will now have to overcome the outermost post but will be aided by the slanted gate and likely has enough early foot to do so. This gelding also faces a difficult transition between classes but can land on the ticket.

#8 UCANTTOUCHTHIS has earned more than anyone in the contest with over \$110,000 in the bank. He finally broke through with a victory in his latest when he scored by more than three lengths in 1:52.3 at even money in NW1. He competed on some big stages in the OSS last season and is worth considering, even though he also steps upwards in class.

#3 ARMOR SEELSTER is another that broke his maiden in his latest and will now tackle tougher foes in NW2. He came into this season off a pair of strong looking qualifiers and has not been no worse than second in two parimutuel events. This gelding can pick up a share.

- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

Smoking Regulations

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

HOW TO BET

Please call your bets to a teller in the following manner: Amount of base bet, type of bet, horse numbers.
 Examples: \$3.00 to Win, number 7; \$5.00 Daily Doubles, 6 and 4, 7 and 5.
 The minimum amount for a single bet in any pool other than Superfect, Pick 3 and Pick 4 is \$1.00.

TYPES OF BETS

The following types of bets may be made on each race:
WIN - You must select the winner of the race.
PLACE - Your horse must finish first, second.
SHOW - Your horse must finish first, second or third.
 The following "feature" bets are available on one or more races as indicated in the program:
DAILY DOUBLE - Select the winner of two consecutive races for the races designated as the Daily Double events. This bet must be placed before the first race.
EXACTOR - Select the first two horses in exact order of finish.
TRIACTOR - Select the first three horses in exact order of finish.
SUPERFACTA - Select the first four horses in exact order of finish.
PICK 3 - Select the winner of three consecutive races for the races designated as Pick 3 events.
PICK 4 - Select the winners of four consecutive races for the races designated as Pick 4 events.

BOXES AND WHEELS

By "boxing" or "wheeling", you can combine several bets on one ticket, as follows:

DAILY DOUBLE

Wheel one "key" horse in the 1st race with several horses in the 2nd race or several horses in the 1st race with one horse in the second race - your ticket is cashable if the key horse and one of your choices in the other race are both winners.
 Example \$1.00 Daily Double Wheel, number 3 "on top" with a nine horse field, cost is \$9.00 (9 combinations)

EXACTOR BOXES & WHEELS

Box two, three or more horses - your ticket is cashable if two of the boxed horses finish first and second.
Examples: \$2.00 Exactor Box, 3 and 5 - cost is \$4.00 (2 combinations)
 \$3.00 Exactor Box, 2, 4, 6 - cost is \$18.00 (6 combinations)
 \$1.00 Exactor Box, 1, 3, 5, 8 - cost is \$12.00 (12 combinations)
Wheel one horse to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if that horse finishes in the selected position, -- either first (on top) or second (on bottom).
Example: \$1.00 Exactor Wheel, 3 "on top" - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$8.00.

TRIACTOR BOXES AND WHEELS

Box three, four or more horses - your ticket is cashable if three of the boxed horses finish 1st, 2nd and 3rd, in any order.
Examples: \$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 5 - cost is \$6.00
 \$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5 - cost is \$24.00
 \$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 - cost is \$60.00
 \$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 - cost is \$120.00

SUPERFACTA BOXES AND WHEELS

Box four or more horses - your ticket is cashable if four of the boxed horses finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in any order.
Examples: \$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5 - cost is \$24.00
 \$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 - cost is \$120.00
 \$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 - cost is \$360.00
Key Horse Bet also available - Example: \$1.00 Triactor Key, number 4 with numbers, 5, 6 and 9 - cost is \$6.00 (6 combinations). The ticket is cashable if number 4 (the "Key" horse) wins and two of the numbers, 5, 6 and 9 finish second and third.
 Key horse plus 2 horses = 2 combinations;
 Key horse plus 4 horses = 12 combinations;
 Key horse plus 5 horses = 20 combinations; etc.
Wheel two horses to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if the two specified horses finished in the selected positions.
Example: \$1.00 Triactor Wheel 2 - 6 - "all" - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$7.00 (7 combinations). Variations: all - 2 - 6, 2 - all - 6.
Wheel one horse to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if that horse finishes in the selected position:
Examples: \$1.00 Triactor Wheel, 5 - all - all - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$56.00 (56 combinations).
 \$2.00 Triactor Wheel, all - 8 - all - with an 8-horse field, cost is \$84.00 (42 combinations).

PARTIAL WHEELS

If you don't want to include all horses in a wheel bet, specify "Part Wheel" and call the horses's numbers individually.
Examples: \$1.00 Exactor Part Wheel, 7 with 1, 2, 4 and 9 - cost is \$4.00 (4 combinations) and the ticket is cashable if number 7 wins and any of numbers 1, 2, 4 or 9 finishes second.
 \$2.00 Triactor Part Wheel, 3 with 8 with 1, 2, 4 and 9 - cost is \$8.00 (4 combinations) and the ticket is cashable if number 3 wins and number 8 finishes second and any of numbers, 1, 2, 4 or 9 finishes 3rd.

PLEASE NOTE

When calling **Box** or **Wheel** bets to a teller, specify the amount of the base bet - **for example:** \$1.00 Triactor Box, \$2.00 Exactor Wheel - and not the total cost of the wager.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
