

# DISCORD DOXXING GUIDE

## METHOD 1:

Most users add connections to their Discord account, such as Spotify, Instagram, and more. Go over every single one and use Google to search for these usernames and links. For instance, if there's a playlist on Spotify, search for the playlist link on Google, example query "https://spotify...". This might reveal places where the playlist was shared, and the same applies for other social media usernames and links.

## METHOD 2:

Use a Discord database search engine like [namedc.org](https://namedc.org). Search for the user ID, and in most cases, you'll find past usernames, display names, avatars, etc. Use this information to search on Google and continue your investigation.

## METHOD 3:

Utilize Google to search for the ID or username. For example, search for terms like "134243242" or "banan.yt". This can lead you to sites where the Discord ID was linked or sites that use the same username.

## METHOD 4:

Search for past messages where the user might have revealed their identity. Find servers they are part of and search in all channels for messages with keywords like "birthday", "username", and more.

## METHOD 5:

Employ social engineering techniques. This could involve getting on a call with the user and persuading them to turn on screen share to gather valuable information. Other tactics include catfishing to extract information or tricking them into downloading malicious software.
