

# How To Multiplayer In Minecraft PE (Bedrock).

You can play Minecraft alone or with a group of players. This makes the game even more enjoyable and enjoyable. There are many ways to create multiplayer games. Each has pros and cons. However, the procedure is straightforward, but it could differ depending on the platform or distance between players and their friends.

## 1) Sending an invitation to a friend

Gamers can either send invitations to their friends to join their world, or join their friends' world. It's a simple procedure where players need to open the game and enter the world they want to invite their friends. Once they have entered the world, they must send an invitation to their friend.

Xbox Live friends can be added to Minecraft, and in case the name of the friend isn't showing, players can add them via their gamer tag.

## 2) LAN setup

Users must be connected to the same Wi Fi network to play multiplayer games with this method. Once done, they should start their game before entering the world they wish to play in, players must go to its multiplayer settings and turn on the visible to LAN Players option.

The host then launches the world and their friends can join the game by clicking the Play button, which will take them to the Play menu. Here, they can navigate through the Friends section at the top of the page and play the game's corresponding LAN game.

### 3) Joining online server

To connect to an online server in Minecraft Bedrock, players should know the server's name, address/URL, and port number. Once you have all the information open the game and select Play. From there, navigate to Servers from the Play Menu. There will be plenty of servers available.

Gamers can join any of these servers. If Roof Info would like to add another server, they must scroll down until they find the Add Server option. After filling out all the information, players can join the server that appeals to them.

They can browse [MinecraftPocket-Servers](#) or [Minecraftlist.org](#) to find and join the server they feel best suits them.

### 4) Minecraft Realms

Minecraft Realm gives players the most enjoyable multiplayer experience. It offers a variety of worlds to explore. It also allows them to make and host their own games.

Ten players can play on the server simultaneously and the most impressive feature is that even when the host is offline the other players can still play for free.

It is very easy to create Realms in Minecraft Bedrock Edition. To create Realms in the Minecraft Bedrock Edition, players must start their Play menu. The Realms option is available just below the Create New button in Worlds. Once the realm has been established, players can invite their friends to join it.

The players are only able to join Realms only if they are invited. Once the invitation is accepted, players must simply navigate through the Play menu and then go to the Friends section. Here, they will be able to see the name of the Realm they have been invited to, and tap it to join.
