'Minecraft' October Updates are Big News for VR and Tweakers

Minecraft is nearing updates that could seriously alter how you play when you want to play with the game's mechanics... or simply immerse yourself in a virtual world. The update that will be released on October 18th for Minecraft's Windows 10 Pocket and Gear VR editions will include Add-ons. These will allow users to alter text files to change the behavior of objects and characters. Do you want giant chickens, or Creepers that trigger huge explosions? It's simple to make. It's an excellent method to enter the world of mods without knowing programming.

VR users have better controller support. Nbjyxspa You can utilize the Bluetooth-equipped Xbox One gamepad (like the one that ships with the Xbox One S) in the Windows 10 or Gear VR versions of the game and PC players with an Oculus Rift can also use Oculus Touch hand controllers. If Minecraft in VR is still an ordinary PC or mobile game at the moment but it will be a more distinctive experience following the update.

The new software also brings boss battles for the Windows 10, Pocket and Gear VR versions.

Console gamers won't have to wait until the 18th to get something new, though. Microsoft and Mojang are releasing the Chinese Mythology Mash-Up that, as the name suggests introduces characters and a world that are influenced by the Chinese culture. You'll also see banners and more natural biomes, including Igloos and polar bears, which are found in the arctic regions. Xbox and Wii U gamers get this update on October 4th, whereas the PlayStation crowd gets it on the 5th.
