

How do I fix Google Chrome empty response (ERR_EMPTY_RESPONSE) error?

Sometimes we might get an error on the computer screen ERR_EMPTY_RESPONSE while trying to get access to a website and contact the [Google customer service](#) to get the problem fixed. But you can easily fix this kind of errors yourself without contacting the customer care.

You need to know the reason of the problem so that you can try to fix it. This might be due to any of the reasons such as:

- Incorrect device settings
- Drivers not working
- Network settings problem
- Not using the VPN
- Network disconnection

There could be some other reasons as well but you can try to fix this problem by following these useful tips:

- Delete the browsing data: If there is too much browsing data in the browser it might show you ERR_EMPTY_RESPONSE, you can clear the data and get the problem fixed right away.
- Reset the network settings: Resetting the network settings you will be able to reach the webpage faster and you will not get this problem.
- Update the drivers (internal system software): If the Google Chrome drivers are stopped you will get this error on your device.
- Use a VPN: If you are using a VPN on your device, you will never face the problem of ERR_EMPTY_RESPONSE.
- Network connection: You need to check the network connection by using other device or browser. If you are not getting the internet from the internet service

provider you will get the same error. Once you fixed the internet connection problem this error will also be fixed automatically.
