Installing mods on Minecraft servers hosted on VPSs or your personal PC can bring many benefits, from optimizing game performance to exploring new places. There are numerous mods available - most of them free, developed by the community for the community.

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Top 5 Utility and Performance Minecraft Mods

These are the best Minecraft mods, which help players get more out of their gaming experience. They provide useful game optimization features as well as solving in-game issues.

1. OptiFine

Minecraft version: 1.7.2 – 1.18.1

OptiFine, a popular Minecraft mod, is an optimization mod to make the game run smoother and faster. In addition to the numerous rendering options and graphics, users can also use different shader packs.

This mod provides two essential features that improve gameplay: VSync and FPS boost. VSync or vertical synchronization synchronizes the game framerate with the monitor's refresh rate, and removes split frame.

You can also alter the appearances of various elements of the game, such as water, snow, trees and rain, or objects in the skies. OptiFine supports HD textures as well as fonts and custom colors.

2. Sodium

Minecraft version: 1.6.1 - 1.17.1

Sodium is a Minecraft modded version that improves the game's performance and visuals. It's similar to OptiFine. This one was created to be used in conjunction with the Fabric modloader.

It increases the visual quality of the machine while reducing strain. Its smooth lighting and biome blending of fluids and special blocks are just a few examples.

The mod also features many features that help to make Minecraft run faster. It uses multi-threading to perform block updates, which reduces lag spikes. Additionally, it culls invisible

chunk face graphics to reduce memory bandwidth usage.

Users can also use this Minecraft mod for multiple shaders at high FPS and easily switch between them.

3. Here's What You're Looking At

Here's What you're Looking At, or HYWLA, is one of the most useful and lightweight Minecraft mods. It allows players to identify any block or other item in the game.

Simply hover the cursor on an item to reveal its details. It can even tell you which mod the item comes from.

This mod is the successor to a popular utility mod called "What Am I Looking At" or WAILA. It is no longer up-to-date.

4. Clumps

Minecraft version: Version 1.10.2 – 1.18.1

This Minecraft mod is optimized to focus on one reason FPS drops: there are many experience orbs in the area at once.

These orbs allow players to gain enough experience in order to enchant their weapons and armor. Your system will often struggle to render all floating objects.

Clumps solves the problem by grouping all experience orbs in a specific area into one orb. This reduces lag as well as the amount of rendering required. This simple Minecraft mod also enables the player to collect orbs automatically upon touching them.

5. JourneyMap

Minecraft version 1.0.0 - 1.17.1

While a map object has been around for a while in Minecraft, many players aren't impressed with its complex functionality. It only displays so much. The geographical data it provides is

often blurry and not helpful.

JourneyMap is a tool that allows users to view the world through a custom map. Players can display a minimap in the corner, a fullscreen map or even a separate map in a separate browser window while they play.

The map provides real-time information to gamers about the terrain, where they are, and other in-game elements. This Minecraft mod offers many configurable options for displaying information. You can view biomes and icons, FPS, waypoints and icons, as well as other players.

5 Best Minecraft Mob Mods to Try Out

Mobs refer to various creatures in Minecraft with whom players can interact. These creatures include monsters, villagers and animals as well as other players.

1. Pixelmon

2. Mowzie's Mobs

Mowzie's Mobs mod adds many enemies to Minecraft. This mod adds more difficulty to Minecraft by adding hostile mobs.

These creatures have unique AI codes and are found in different biomes all over the world. For example, players might encounter Foliaath, the man-eating plants, in the jungle. However, the heavily armored Ferrous Wroughtnaut cannot be found underground.

3. The Twilight Forest

Minecraft version: 1.7.1 - 1.7.10

This mod focuses primarily on adventure and exploration, with a strong emphasis on traversing forests and dungeons. You can also collect unique items and meet strange creatures.

The Twilight Forest is home to three types of creatures: passive, harmless, hostile mobs as well as bosses or larger enemies. Boss creatures tend to reside in their respective structures, and defeating them will unlock new areas of the Twilight Forest.

For example, the Naga can usually be found in Naga Courtyard. The Knight Phantom can be found in dark forest biome.

4. Dragons: Ice and fire

Minecraft version: 1.10.2-1.16.5

This Minecraft mod adds dragons into the base game. The mod includes dragons that are not only hostile but can also be tamed.

As dragon hunters, players can engage in many adventures that include collecting dragon skeletons scales eggs and scales as well as finding treasures. You can craft tools and weapons with dragon bones, while dragon scales can be used to create armor. Those who have successfully tamed their dragons can even ride them.

There are three types of dragons: ice, fire, and lightning. This Minecraft mod allows you to create other magical creatures such as trolls and hydras.

5. Lycanites Mobs

Minecraft version: 1.1.7.10 - 1.1.5

Built for the Forge mod loader, this Minecraft mod adds over 100 new mobs to various dimensions and biomes. The creatures include harmless and farmable animals, hostile beings, and elementals spawning from nature.

A Minecraft player can summon or dismiss a creature by taming it with the Soulstone. Players can summon a group of creatures to help them fight, or to protect their basecamp while they are away with a Summoning Staff and Pedestal.

Other activities include creating powerful tools and weapons, exploring dungeon systems and adding new ones, and summoning boss creatures by building altars.

Top 5 Minecraft Mods for Solo Play

Although enjoying Minecraft with fellow players is great, playing the game in single-player can also be a lot of fun.

These are the top Minecraft mods for anyone who wants to explore Minecraft worlds alone.

1. RLCraft

RLCraft is a popular Minecraft modpack. RL stands for Real Life or Realism. It includes more than 100 Minecraft mods combined to make a more challenging experience. This mod allows players to encounter elements like dragons and dungeons.

Most of the mechanics found in vanilla Minecraft have been modified to make the game more realistic and elevate the level of difficulty.

For example, a player can cut down a tree to gain wood in regular Minecraft. But this mod requires the use of a flint knife.

There is also the addition of the player's body temperature and thirst level, extra health for players and mobs, and sound filters adding reverb to caves and muted sounds when the player is underwater or in lava.

2. Farming Valley

Minecraft version: 1.10.2

Farming Valley modpack was created for fans of Harvest Moon and Stardew Valley games. It turns Minecraft into a game that focuses on building a farm or developing a small community.

Players can plant, harvest, and sell crops to obtain money. There are four seasons within the game, and each season has its own special set of plantable crops. Some examples include cabbage, corn, and eggplant.

Gamers can take care and sell animals such as milk, eggs, and wool in addition to growing crops.

You can sell crops to NPCs who have their own names. Talking to NPCs and giving them gifts can help players build relationships. They can eventually get married.

3. JurassiCraft

Minecraft version: 1.8.9 - 1.12.2

JurassiCraft is a great mod for dinosaur enthusiasts. It adds prehistoric plants to Minecraft and dinosaurs to the world. Players can generate baby dinosaurs by extracting DNA from fossils and processing it using various machines.

Users can add buildings and blocks to cities, as well as modify how they are created. Haunted buildings is for those who love to engage in combat. They can create hostile mobs that will continue to spawn until they have killed a set number.

Additionally, gamers can combine The Lost Cities and Lost Souls. This mod will make haunted buildings even more challenging by increasing the power of appearing mobs.

5. SkyFactory 4.

Containing over 200 Minecraft mods and over 30 world types, SkyFactory 4 is the fourth version of the original 2014 SkyFactory skyblock modpack.

Skyblock is a popular survival mode that requires players to create and expand their Minecraft worlds using minimal materials. With this mod, the player typically starts in an empty world on top of a tree with a block of dirt underneath it.

SkyFactory's unique resource-gathering system is a noteworthy feature. Sky Orchard saplings can now be planted by players. They will become trees that produce resources like iron and gravel as well as gold. This Minecraft mod also features an optional prestige mode that allows players to unlock new items and mobs via an open progression.

1. Just Enough Items

Minecraft version: 1.8 – 1.12.2

There are hundreds of items and many recipes in Minecraft. It can be difficult to keep track of

them all. This mod, also known as JEI, allows users to view and edit Minecraft recipes and items.

Although Minecraft's latest version offers a recipe book, it can be difficult for players to use. It only allows them to view 25 items at a given time. JEI, on the other hand, allows users to search and sort through hundreds of Minecraft items and can even sort them by source and function.

When you click on an item, the tool will display how to obtain it. In addition, this Minecraft Forge mod is compatible with most Minecraft mods.

2. Create

Minecraft version: 1.14.4 – 1.18.1

Create is a mod helping players create different useful contraptions and automate processes with rotational power. It also adds new building blocks and mechanical components to vanilla Minecraft.

The Minecraft mod has many generators that produce rotational force. Examples include a water wheel, the generator that produces power when water flows over it, and a furnace engine, which generates power when an item is smelted or cooked in a furnace or smoker.

The power produced by generators is then used to power machines. The mechanical press and blaze torch are two examples of craftable machinery. The press is used to pack, press, or compact items. The blaze burner heats basins for following recipes.

3. Chisels and Bits

Minecraft version: 1.1.5 - 1.8.9

One of the best Minecraft mods for creating structures with intricate design, Chisels and Bits lets players sculpt blocks using chisels of different tiers. Players can choose whether to cut down a block that is full-sized or a single voxel. A block of normal size can be broken into 64 smaller pieces.

There are five types of chisels: stone, iron and gold, as well as diamond and netherite. The stone chisel is the entry-level chisel with limited usage, letting users chisel up to 131 blocks.

The netherite, which is the strongest, can chisel as much as 2031 blocks.

The chisel allows players to create custom stairs and pillars. This Forge mod lets players copy and paste designs they create, so you don't have to make the same design over and over again.

4. WorldEdit

Minecraft version: 1.1.18.1 - 1.7.10

WorldEdit, a Minecraft construction mod, provides all the tools needed to speed up building processes. To build different structures, players can use different mathematical equations and shared construction files.

You can use Minecraft commands to create, copy and paste different area plans. You can also use the tools to instantly select and fill areas and create different shapes using blocks such as cuboids or spheres.

This construction tool allows you to add or remove thousands of blocks in a matter of seconds, making it easier to create large structures. There are also tools for manipulating terrain. You can also create snowy areas, forests and pumpkin patches. You can also build mountains with handheld tools and brushes.

5. BuildCraft

Minecraft version: 1.5.2 - 1.7.10

This mod lets players experiment with their creativity as well as scale production. BuildCraft is a tool that allows you to transport fluids, objects, and mechanical energy from one machine to another.

Portals and doors can be used to teleport players into different traps, puzzles, or mazes.

Players can also cast magic, tame and fight various mobs. Players will receive coins upon

completing quests that can be exchanged to get valuable rewards.

3. Enigmatica 2: Expert

This modpack is the Enigmatica 2 expert version. The difficulty level of Enigmatica 2 Expert is higher than the regular version. It includes more difficult crafting recipes and tougher enemies. This modpack contains over 600 quests.

You can also make your own tools and start science projects like building airships or jetpacks. Furthermore, they can experience unique magical abilities, such as star or blood magic.

Adventure is provided by the mod, which includes underground structures, cave networks, ruins, and other planets in more than 20 dimensions.

5. SevTech: Ages

Minecraft version: 1.12.2

The Futuristic Age will offer players the opportunity to unlock space mobs that include hungry zombies and skeletons as well as witches and Endermen.
