- 3. Your application must be prepared and sealed per 30 TAC §326.69(b). Resubmit the title page and table of contents to include the seal of a professional engineer who is registered in the State of Texas, in accordance with 30 TAC §326.69(b)(1). In addition, please be advised that the Texas Board of Professional Engineers (TBPE) adopted rule revisions that require all licensees to include the name and registration number of the registered engineering firm for which they are doing the work, on sealed documents, in accordance with 22 TAC §137.33(n).
- 4. In accordance with 30 TAC §326.69(e), provide a Uniform Resource Locator (URL) address of a publicly accessible internet website where the application and all revisions to the application will be posted in "Section 1.4 Posting of Application on Website" of the Medical Waste Registration Form (TCEQ-20789) application.
- 5. Provide a revised adjacent and potentially affected landowners property map to show all property ownership within ½ mile of the facility and all mineral interest ownership under the facility. The revised map should be submitted as described in 30 TAC §326.69(d) as well as be signed and sealed by the professional on record.
- 6. In accordance with 30 TAC §326.69(d), application drawings, review all drawings and maps as needed and ensure all maps are signed and sealed by the professional on record.
- 7. For future correspondence, the professional of record should sign and stamp the application before the applicant in "Section 6 Applicant Certification and Signature" of the Medical Waste Registration Form (TCEQ-20789) application.

- Provide a dated cover letter with the revised application;
