

# Dr Ciara Kelly reveals son's MMR vaccine injury



## Former GP Goes Public on son's Vaccine Injury

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Dr Ciara Kelly former GP now a broadcaster and medical journalist working for Newstalk Radio recently revealed her 19-year-old son suffered a catastrophic vaccine injury after being administered the primary dose MMR vaccine at age 18 months.

Speaking in a twitter exchange Dr Kelly shocked her followers by giving graphic details of the life-threatening injuries her son received

**“My eldest had that after MMR - was in Crumlin for a week... temp of 42 and was like a little red lobster...”**

Dr Kelly went on to describe the emergency admission to hospital and the week-long stay while her son underwent lifesaving treatment with a fever and temperature of 42 degrees celsius. Treatment included multiple drips, blood tests, medications and a lumbar puncture in order to save him.

**“My eldest had RXN to MMR hyperpyrexia. refractory temp of 42C... roasting and agitated in OLHSC x 5 days had lumbar puncture multiple drips bloods meds... it was horrible”**

The former GP continued in the tweet exchange to state the reaction her son had was in her opinion, much better than him having the measles.

Thankfully the child survived, however questions remain on lasting damage which may have been sustained as a result. Dr Kelly neither confirmed nor denied her son suffered any lasting brain or other physical or mental damage.

It is hard to imagine such injuries would leave no residual condition considering retrograde Temperature of 42 degrees Celsius can cause brain injury, being the cut-off point when organs can suffer irreparable damage.

The further symptoms reported by the former GP all have serious consequences...

**Hyperpyrexia** – dangerous condition can lead to organ failure and death if untreated

**Roasting and Agitated** – danger of seizure

**Hospitalised for 5 days** – serious reaction requiring intensive care

**Lumbar Puncture** – invasive procedure with significant risks

**Multiple Drips** – required in serious cases

**Blood Tests** – invasive tests required to ascertain causes

**Medications** - required to treat the injury

Dr Kelly is currently advocating forced vaccination of all school children, demanding they be banned from School/Creche unless fully vaccinated. Minister Simon Harris' comments recently suggested that while such a stance was against the Irish Constitution, he was in agreement **“in principal”**

Dr Kelly as a former GP appears oblivious to the fact that not all children could survive the ordeal her son encountered without injury or even death.

Giving rise to speculation that where such a grave risk exists, to deny parents a choice of whether or not to take it is unethical as well as unconstitutional.

As an advocate for the MMR vaccine Dr Kelly had previously stated there were no safety risks from the vaccine. (Twitter 3/08/2017)

**“... there are ZERO safety concerns”**

That statement would appear to be completely contradicted now in light of the recent revelations that her son did in fact suffer a severe vaccine injury.

The consequences of which are unknown however raise a number of questions which remain unanswered...

- Did the GP or hospital report this vaccine reaction to the IMB as it was then, now known since 2014 as the HPRA?
- Did the child receive a second or any subsequent dose of MMR?
- If so, was there any further adverse reaction?
- Did Dr Kelly make patients aware that such severe reactions can occur with this vaccine?
- Did the child display any signs of mental or physical health problems after this reaction?

- Has this child ever received a referral to an SLT, OT, PT, Neurologist, Psychologist or Psychiatrist?
- Did the child have any special needs help during his childhood or schooling?

Dr Ciara Kelly was recently featured in newspaper articles proposing that parents need to be threatened; unless they give up their constitutional right to bodily integrity and submit to forced vaccination, they face the prospect of their children being denied a further constitutional right to an education.

While more usual for such information to be strictly guarded, Dr Kelly by revealing her son's medical history cannot expect it to go unchallenged.

Moreover, considering this medical professional and broadcaster occupies a position of some influence and prominence in Irish society, while advocating a constitutional override in favour of administering forced medication to minors, against their parent's wishes.
